# Man Does Not Know His Greatest Enemy

You can't conquer your enemy if you don't even know him.

O MATTER HOW BAD THE NEWS IS, MOST OF OUR LEADers in this world still believe they have a solution to world problems. The terrifying truth is, not one of them knows how to solve the world's evils, especially our number-one problem of human survival.

Man does not understand the basic *cause* of our extreme immorality, violence, crime and war. He doesn't understand *why* we are on the brink of obliterating all human life from this planet.

Here is a paragraph from our booklet *Human Nature—What Is It*? (request your free copy): "The human mind: What a wonder! It can produce the most sophisticated computer technology imaginable. We have sent men to walk on the surface of the moon—a robot to crawl on the surface of Mars, photographing the terrain for us to examine. Yet the same minds which produce such marvels of science and technology Cannot solve human evils, like war, violence, crime, immorality, dishonesty and deceit. The awesome mind of man has not brought about lasting peace. Indeed, the mind of man, contrary to what some modern scholars might think, has produced an abundance of evil, heartache and bloodshed. The question is, why? How can a mind that produces such incredible technology utterly fail when it comes to solving world problems?"

MAN IS FACING TOTAL ANNIHILATION OF ALL HUMAN LIFE, PERHAPS IN A DECADE OR LESS. That is especially true when you consider the mad leader of Iran, who is about to get nuclear weapons and is eager to use them. Iran is by far the greatest terrorist-sponsoring nation in this nuclear world—madness that no nation or group of nations has been willing to take a stand against—yet. The country's leader, Mahmoud Ahmadinejad, believes a nuclear war would hasten the return of his version of the Messiah.

# Was Planned!

As an EU member state implodes, look who stands to benefit. By RON FRASER AND ROBERT MORLEY

UROPE IS AT A CROSSROADS!

Greece is on the verge of collapse. This Mediterranean nation cannot pay its debts without massive restructuring. Both French and German ministers have announced that they will not bail out their Club Med neighbor. Instead, EU monetary authorities are push-

ing Greece to massively slash its budget.

But if Greece were to implement the severe

spending cuts needed to get its deficit un-

der control, it could easily plunge into an

even deeper recession. Also, loss of govern-

ment handouts has already created mass strikes and social unrest-a trend certain to get worse as the cuts become more steep.

Yet if Germany and France allow Greece to continue defying its monetary agreements, there will be little to stop other deeply indebted countries like Spain, Portugal and Ireland from also reneging on their monetary commitments. The credibility of the euro would be thrown into doubt.

All eyes are on Europe. Can the euro survive if Greece leaves or is kicked out of the monetary union? If a bailout comes, who will fund it, and at what cost?

There are no good choices. All of them will be very costly. Greece's massive debt problems threaten the very viability of the European Union.

The disparate nations of Europe are desperately seeking a savior.

The truly remarkable thing is, THIS CRISIS WAS NO ACCIDENT. Not only was it eminently foreseeable long ago, but evidence suggests that it was deliberately planned. And its outcome promises to unfold just as its authors hoped.

What is happening in the European superstate is a mystery to most of the world. Yet while stock markets gyrate and bond investors panic, Trumpet readers know the ultimate result.

"The crisis in Greece is a forerunner of a whole rash of similar crises set to soon break out across Europe," editor in chief Gerald Flurry wrote in the February 2009 *Trumpet.* "They will provide the catalyst for

the EU's leading nation, Germany, to rise to the fore with solutions of ITS OWN MAKING."

For more than a decade, the *Trumpet* has warned about the rotten heart of Europe. We have specifically noted the flawed currency exchange rate mechanism and how the structure of the EU was a Trojan horse for stealthy German ambitions.

"Who will get control of this great superstate?" asked Mr. Flurry in June 2000. The battle comes down to two nations—France and Germany, he said. But it will be the nation that controls the money— Germany—that will ultimately reign supreme.

Today, events unfolding in Europe are proving that forecast uncannily accurate.

#### **Created to Fail?**

From the beginning, the euro was destined—maybe even designed—to fail. At least that is the conclusion of some analysts.

Back in 1992, the power elites in Europe

enticed the hapless member nations of the EU at that time into signing up to the Maastricht Treaty on European Union. The treaty contained a vital clause creating the foundation for an economic and monetary union—EMU. This has become synonymous with the subsequent European Monetary Union, also called the EMU.

The EMU was glued together by a single currency. The euro was introduced in 1999, with notes and coins entering circulation in 2002. To date 16 EU member nations have joined the EMU, sacrificing their individual national sovereign means of exchange—and in the process setting themselves on a course that would lead to the total sacrifice of their national sovereignty on the altar of the imperialist project of the European Union.

After the EU single currency system was implemented, certain voices predicted the failure of the euro. A handful

theorized that the euro may well even have been *deliberately created to fail* by certain German elites. The theory was that Germany would bide its time and allow the unworkable monetary union to prevail till it reached a point of collapse and then, having wrested control of the European Central Bank (ECB) out of any competitor's hands (read France, in particular), move in quickly and take direct control of EMU administration. Germany could then ensure that a preferred core of EU member nations would receive ECB favor, with the disfavored reduced to vassal status or worse.

Why, if the theory is correct, would Germany deliberately create an economic and monetary union that was destined, from all the tests applied by the clearest thinking observers at the time, to fail?

#### **Unification Through Stealth**

When the eurozone's founders began working toward pan-European unity, they knew it would be virtually impossible to unite the Continent. Jean Monnet, one of the forefathers of the European Union, was well aware of the difficulty of convincing voters to willingly relinquish their national sovereignty. Monnet felt that the only way to achieve unification, without war, was through stealth. The people must not know that sovereignty has been surrendered until it is gone.

English conservative and author Adrian Hilton described Monnet's intentions for Europe this way: "Europe's nations should be guided towards a superstate without their people understanding what is happening. This can be accomplished by successive steps each disguised as having an economic purpose, but which will eventually and irreversibly lead to federation" (The Principality and Power of Europe; emphasis ours throughout).

As Monnet said on April 30, 1952, "The fusion [of economic functions] would compel nations to fuse their sovereignty into that of a single European state."

Peter Thorneycroft, former chancellor of the Exchequer of the United Kingdom and Europhile, described the Monnet unification method in a 1957 Foreign Affairs article: "The idea of a united Europe is not new. It has exercised the minds of the soldiers and sometimes of the statesmen of Europe for many centuries. ... Torn by war and conquest, weakened by internecine strife, Europeans have yet found the time and the capacity to leave an incomparable legacy ....

"Yet men do not live easily within the same institutional arrangements. National patriotisms are strong ...."

In an earlier booklet, *Design for Europe* (1947), Thorneycroft wrote: "No government dependent upon a democratic vote could possibly agree in advance to the sacrifice which any adequate plan must involve. The people must be led slowly and unconsciously into the abandonment of their traditional economic defenses, not asked, in advance ...."

Economic integration, once initiated, would become self-sustaining, it was hoped. Monnet theorized that economic interdependence would drive integration until eventually, Europe would end up with de facto political centralization and unification.

Today, Europe may be at a tipping point where economic integration finally meets political unification.

"The European experiment with a trans-sovereign currency is facing its first acid test," wrote Euro Pacific Capital's John Browne. "In essence, the euro was created as a lever to encourage a complete European political union rather than as a currency representing ... an already unified economy" (February 10).

According to Browne, who is a former British member of Parliament and close associate of then Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher, the euro has largely succeeded in *creating the will for a federal Europe* among the political classes even though European citizens have voted again and again to maintain their individual country's sovereignty.

"Whoever controls the currency controls the government," said economics guru Maynard Keynes. To him, that was not just a law of economics; it was a law that underwrote power politics.


#### **Anticipated Crisis**

When the euro was created, a chain of events was set in motion. For nations like Greece, a future debt crisis was almost inevitable.

By joining the eurozone, Greece traded its inflation-prone drachma for the stability of the euro. It also gained the economic borrowing clout of a superstar, even though it had the economy of a small supporting actor.

Initially, these two advantages vastly improved the standard of living for the people of Greece. They allowed corporations, individuals and government to borrow money at the low rates typical within large developed countries like Germany. The new low interest rates were more than Greece could resist. All levels of society binged on seemingly cheap money. The

But as lenders to Greece are beginning to remember, there was a good reason Greece paid far higher interest rates to borrow money when it was not a member of the Union. Greece has a history of borrowing too much. According to analyst John Mauldin, Greece has been in default in one way or another for 105 out of the past 200 years.

Even as luxury swiftly came to Greece, so now have the first whiffs of poverty.

With a projected budget deficit of 12.7 percent of the nation's gross domestic product, Greece is far out of compliance with the eurozone's mandated 3 percent maximum. With the world in recession, investors are wondering how Greece will pay its bills.

Typically when a country takes on too much debt, it contracts Argentine-disease. Known also as "quantitative easing," countries devalue their currency by turning on the money printing presses and simply creating the currency to pay the bills. This of course upsets creditors, but at least the bills get paid. The economy also gets a short-term kick-start because a devalued currency makes exported goods less expensive; thus foreigners buy more domestic products.

Greece, however, does not have this option. Since it is locked into the euro, it does not control the printing presses. Germany does.

Analysts worry that Greece may be reaching the point where a debt spiral could bankrupt the government. What will Europe do?

It's true that the Greece crisis will necessitate some difficult and costly decisions. But in some respects, as far as the European political class is concerned, it matters not whether Greece stays or goes. Greece is a peripheral country, immaterial to the desire for a federalist Europe. What is material is that the current crisis be exploited to its maximum—and that means that it be used to foster further integration of core Europe.

#### Will the Eurozone Be Pared Down?

The *Telegraph*'s Ambrose Evans-Pritchard wrote on January 31 that the solution to the crisis could involve *a paring down of the eurozone*. He noted the possibility of a bloc of nations centered on Germany leaving the eurozone and creating a new currency: the Deutsch mark 2. The rest of

the eurozone countries would then be free to devalue the euro (turn on the printing presses) to pay down debts.

Although Evans-Pritchard noted that Germany is currently happy with its advantageous position within the euro, he also said there would be certain benefits to a newly created German-led bloc.

Events in Greece bear close watching, especially in light of the advent of the sev-

enth revival of the Holy Roman Empire in Europe, which officially began on January 1 with the onset of the Lisbon Treaty.

The first major reason to watch this issue is that the Bible indicates that this final Roman imperial resurrection will be composed of 10 nations or groups of nations (as indicated in Daniel 2). Whether or not the current 27 EU nations get regrouped into new political regions remains to be seen, but the economic crisis in Greece may well provoke a vast restructuring or paring down of the European Union.

Far from heralding the *end* of the European unification project, the current crisis in Greece may actually signal a new beginning.

#### **Forcing the Pace of Political Union**

Back when the euro was first created, the European Commission's top economists warned politicians that the new currency might not survive a serious crisis. They knew that because the eurozone had "no EU treasury or debt union to back it up" and a "one-size-fits-all regime of interest rates [that] caters badly to the different needs of Club Med and *the German bloc*," the day would come that economic crisis would threaten the EU (*Telegraph*, Oct. 1, 2008).

The fathers of the euro did not dispute this. They knew European economic union was risky, but they saw it as an acceptable risk—even desirable—as a last-ditch option to force the pace of political union. As the *Telegraph* said,

"They welcomed the idea of a 'beneficial crisis." And as "ex-Commission chief Romano Prodi remarked, it would allow Brussels to break taboos and accelerate the move to a full-fledged EU economic government" (ibid.).

Mr. Flurry's words from that February 2009 article ring out: "Berlin has been planning for this crisis before it even adopted the euro. European elites knew it would eventually come. And THEY WILL SOON PRESENT A SOLUTION."

Sure enough, in the midst of the Greek crisis, an increasing ensemble is crying for a federalized European economic government—one with not just a common currency, but one with a common debt union and power structure—kind of like a United States of America in Europe.

It is "Time for the Eurozone to Grow Up," headlined the *Wall Street Journal* on February 8. There is a way out of this dilemma, it wrote. "It would require a *European federal government* with substantial taxing and spending power, with the ability to redistribute resources and impose fiscal discipline across the continent. In short, it would require a *far greater degree of political union* .... Yet the choice is now clear and inescapable."

That is exactly the kind of talk that political elites are looking for. It is also a sentiment echoed in Europe.

"The crisis has revealed our weaknesses," said European Union President Herman Van Rompuy in February. "Recent developments in the euro area highlight the urgent need to strengthen our economic governance." Europe needs a powerful "economic government," he said.

The EU's foreign affairs chief, Catherine Ashton, agrees. More political union is needed, she said on February 6 at the Munich Security Conference. "We must mobilize all our levers of influence—political, economic, plus civil and military crisis management tools—in support of a single political strategy."

"The days when a common EU foreign policy was regarded as mere talk are numbered," Ashton said.

Yes, the days when the free nations of Europe charted their own destiny are indeed numbered.

#### Victory for Berlin

Consider the success of the euro project in the grand scheme of things. By gearing a whole continental economy to a single currency—imposing rules for membership of monetary union that it was clear no member nation could reliably and consistently fulfill—the German elites crafted a scheme designed to create a continental crisis. If they come to control the ECB (and judging by the top candidates for the presidency, which is due to change hands next year, this looks to be a done deal), they will be positioned to respond to that crisis by enacting, at their will, a totally reconstituted European monetary union.

Such a union will vest financial and economic power in the hands of a select group of nations. These core nations will act in consortium under Berlin and Rome's direction to propel the Holy Roman imperial vision to reality. They will no longer be frustrated by having to seek a majority vote from 28 fractious, disparate EU member nations. The weaker nations will simply become slaves to the beck and call of the ECB, beholden to it and its governing authority for their economic survival—a literal fulfillment of the prophecies of Revelation 13.

Whether or not the euro fails under its present stress doesn't change this reality: Given the likely imminent placing of a German in charge of the ECB, Germany is about to directly control the bullion hoard stashed in the vaults of the ECB and beyond. The ECB is headquartered in Frankfurt; the importance of the German elites ensuring the bank lies in Germany's heartland will prove a vital key in securing the bank's wealth in times of crisis. When financial crisis arises, Germany will control the EU's singular currency and hence imperial power over the whole of the EU. It will be a case of game, set and match to Germany.

Some have even mused that, as the day of monetary crisis approaches, the German elites, having positioned themselves to seize control of the ECB, would use an appropriate global institution under EU dominance as a regulator to both control and regulate global trade in the EU's favor.

As regular *Trumpet* readers know, the Bible indicates that a king will soon arise in Europe who will deceitfully gain power and force his authority on Europe. The machinations for this pan-European federalist hijacking are falling into place.

#### **Dictating Europe's Destiny**

The second reason the Greek crisis bears close watch is that the Bible indicates that this European superpower will be dominated by Germany. If this crisis in Europe has shown anything, it is that, at least economically, Germany holds ultimate power in Europe.

Bailout or no bailout: Either way, Germany wins. If Germany and Europe bail out Greece, what will be the cost? If Germany has to ask its citizens to reduce their standard of living to subsidize Greeks, what will it ask Greece for in return? The price is sure to be steep. Conversely, if Germany were to work to remove Greece from the EU, the result would be a slimmer, economically healthier, core Europe with one less voice to dilute German political clout.

Sixty-five years after World War II, Germany is again dictating the destiny of Europe. This should startle the world.

As Britain's Iron Lady, Margaret Thatcher, warned in 1993, "You have not anchored Germany to Europe. You have anchored Europe to a newly dominant, unified Germany. In the end, my friends, you'll find it will not work." It is Germany's national character to dominate, she said.

Germany has hijacked Europe. Greece knows it. Portugal and Ireland will find out next. And probably Britain soon thereafter.

But remember: You read it here first.

#### **Prophecy Fulfilled!**

The true portent of all that is happening in Europe will only be obvious to those who understand the reality of the prophetic words of that once "ambassador for world peace without portfolio," Herbert W. Armstrong.

Relying on the Bible for his vision of the future—and on a deep understanding of world events, coupled with his high-profile discourse with the upper echelons of international leadership—Herbert Arm-

strong powerfully proclaimed these events that have occurred in Europe, especially since the unification of Germany, itself one of his most oft-repeated prophecies. Fully five years before World War II, Herbert Armstrong prophesied these events. He continued to air those same prophecies while Germany lay in abject defeat, then on throughout the *wirtschaftswunder*—the German economic miracle of postwar revival—clear on up to his death four years before the fall of the Berlin Wall and the resultant reunification of Germany.

Ten years before the wall fell—13 years prior to the signing of the Maastricht Treaty which created the European Monetary Union—Herbert Armstrong declared, "I have been proclaiming and writing, ever since 1935, that the final one of the seven eras of the Holy Roman Empire is coming in our generation—a 'United States of Europe,' combining 10 nations or groups of nations in Europe—with A UNION OF CHURCH AND STATE!

"The nations of Europe have been striving to become reunited. They desire a common currency, a single combined military force, a single united GOVERNMENT. They have made a start in the Common Market. They are now working toward a common currency. Yet, on a purely political basis, they have been totally unable to unite. ...

"This new united Europe will be, militarily and economically, as strong, or even more powerful, than either the United States or the USSR. It will be a third gigantic world power! But it will be exceedingly short-lived (Revelation 17:10, 12)—as iron and miry clay are not adhesive, and will not stick together (Daniel 2:42-43)" (*Plain Truth*, January 1979).

made an electrifying statement in our May-June 2009 edition. "This is the biggest news event in the world right now," he explained. "But it is almost totally overlooked by the world's news media." A year later, most of the world's media are *still* overlooking this blockbuster story.

What is that story?

"European nations fear economic collapse," that article said. "Now they are looking to Germany as their financial savior. But they are going to get a lot more than a financial savior!" (emphasis mine throughout).

Then came the statement that we would do well to remember: "You need to watch the September 27 election this year in Germany," Gerald Flurry wrote. "It could very well produce the political leader of the Holy Roman Empire."

Mr. Flurry reiterated this remarkable

prediction in our October issue: "As I write this article, Germany is just weeks from electing a new chancellor. That election and events to unfold from IT are going to bring devastating consequences to this world."

What a whirlwind of activity we have witnessed since those words were penned!

After that election and the subsequent ratification of the Lisbon Treaty by all 27 EU member states, Mr. Flurry referred back to the statement he'd published six months before, writing in our February edition, "I believe we may have witnessed a fulfillment of that prediction."

A close look at just what has happened in Germany and the European Union since that election powerfully validates that impression!

#### **Political Crisis**

If one word could describe the state of

German politics since last September's elections, it is *crisis*.

Almost immediately, reports emerged indicating a widening split in the ruling coalition between Chancellor Merkel's CDU/CSU bloc and Vice Chancellor Guido Westerwelle's Federal Democrats. "Only two months after being sworn in, partners in Chancellor Angela Merkel's coalition government are finding it increasingly difficult to paint over differences on issues ranging from tax cuts to anti-terror measures," Deutsche Welle reported on January 3. The discord continues to be fueled by the very different political profiles of Germany's chancellor, vice chancellor and defense minister.

Though she is still able to command headlines when she appears on a public platform, Angela Merkel has given the impression of being often absent from the scene when trouble boils over between the various conflicting personalities in her coalition. Some have viewed the chancellor as becoming weary of the fray. Whereas it seemed by pure chance she had the golden political touch during much of her first stint as Germany's leader, things have seemed to be quite the reverse since this latest election. Though she still rates high with the public, polls consistently indicate that her defense minister, Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg, rates higher by far as Germany's most popular politician. Meanwhile, Vice Chancellor Westerwelle's popularity rating plunged to single digits in February.

Deep divisions in both economic and defense policy separate Westerwelle and Guttenberg, divisions Merkel has been unable to resolve. Mrs. Merkel's efforts at political progress are weak at a time when Germany needs strong leadership; recession is biting and the people are getting restless. In fact, Germany's coalition government could founder on either of two issues: economic and taxation reform, or defense-related matters.

Germany is ripening for political change. All this as the whole of Europe is looking to Germany—creator of the idea of European union, its main driving force and Europe's most powerful economy by far—for solutions to the accelerating fiscal crisis, the collapsing economies in Eastern and southern Europe, and the rising tide of social unrest this is causing. Yet Germany dithers. The state that leads the Union appears reluctant to take that lead.

The impression of general dither amid crisis is being emphasized by the fact that two nobodies were given the two top posts in the European Union hierarchy created under the Lisbon Treaty—President Herman Van Rompuy and Foreign Minister Catherine Ashton. The result has been mass confusion within the EU hierarchy.

To put it simply, both Germany and the European Union are suffering from a great leadership vacuum.

History indicates it is in times of crisis that Germany requires the *closest scruti-ny*—for that is when it is most dangerous!

#### Model of Democracy?

Many German nationals will tell you they are a model democratic nation. They abhor war and just want to live peacefully, enjoying the good life that the strongest and richest economy in Europe has given them. Germans today generally appear to think they are the very model of peaceful democracy. Yet is that impression really correct?

The best analyses of the German character come from Germans themselves.

Gerhard Marx, who worked for many years as a supporter of Herbert Armstrong, said of his own people, "Even though Germany is presently based on a democratic government, it is wrong to look upon it as a real democracy .... [W]hat Germany has today is more of a bureaucratic democracy. And, of course, as long as the average German finds sufficient food on the table, has a reasonably secure job, is able to save some money for his annual vacation; as long as things are going well, he is in no hurry to throw off this form of democracy.

Many authors have analyzed the Ger-

man national character. Some have described it like Proteus, the creature of mythology that could change shape at a moment's notice. Twenty-five years ago, when it was clear that West Germany had long become the engine of a uniting Europe, journalist Luigi Barzini wrote, "It is therefore once again essential for everybody ... to keep an eye across the Rhine and the Alps and the Elbe in order to figure out, as our fathers, grandfathers, the ancient Romans, and remote ancestors had to do, who the Germans are, who they think they are, what they are doing, and where they will go next, wittingly or unwittingly" (The Europeans).

Within seven years of Barzini writing those words, the political face of Germany had changed. It was no longer divided at the Berlin Wall. East Germany had come in from the cold. Within a short time, the debris of Communist rule was being cleared away in Potsdamer Platz in a newly united city of Berlin, which emerged as the busiest construction site in Europe. Structures reflecting a renewed German pride—the pride of a united German nation—began to rise out of the ground. Then, a decade after the wall came down, statues of Germany's warrior heroes, having gathered dust in storage since Germany's defeat in World War II, began to be preened, polished and

placed on pedestals in public places. German national pride was undergoing a revival.

Last November, Germany partied as it celebrated 20 years of national unity.

Is it not high time that we ask, once again, as Germany reflects renewed pride in its nationality standing head and shoulders above its compatriots in Europe, just who the Germans are today, who they think they are, what they are doing, and where they will go next?

#### **Just What Is Germany Up To?**

As Mr. Flurry mentioned in that May 2009 article, Germany has returned to a status where all Europe is now looking to it as its financial savior. Surely then, given that nation's history when it wields such influence—and combined with the volatile nature of that nation in time of crisis such as the present—we ought to be asking just what the Germans are doing today.

The answer is, *quite a lot*.

The Germans are busy shoring up their capability as the greatest export nation in the world, despite China's recent claim to have taken over that role.

They are busy bidding for the world's top banking job, that of European Central Bank president.

They have worked within the shadows of the EU to establish a regulatory body to control the global economy, the Financial Stability Board.

They are calling the tune on just how the EU will deal with indebted EU member nations such as Greece, nations that are losing pace against the winds of accelerating economic crisis.

The Germans are also, quietly, without a lot of fuss, expanding and strengthening the deployment of their military forces around the world. And the Germans are becoming busy retooling their heavy industry to produce greater amounts of armaments, military machines, ships, submarines and aircraft to prepare for building up a combined European military force. They are steadily exhibiting a greater will to use that force than their appeasing Anglo-Saxon counterparts.

Most Anglo-Saxons are oblivious to all this. In fact, most are totally blind to the reality that what Germany is up to today poses the greatest of risks to international security.

Meanwhile, much publicity is given to the misguided pronouncements on Europe by "experts" across the Atlantic. The Obama administration actually says Europe's leaders *endanger peace* with their

pacifism. "In a withering attack on what Washington sees as European complacency in the face of new security threats," the

Guardian reported, "Robert Gates, the U.S. defense secretary, demanded root-and-branch reform of the transatlantic alliance, voiced exasperation with NATO bureaucracy and said it was becoming increasingly difficult for the U.S. and Europe 'to operate and fight together'" (February 24).

Just how real is this vision of a "pacifist Europe"? Dig below the surface of the journalese of the day and we find another story emerging.

#### Germany's Power Within the EU

The Germans have a history of embracing authoritarian rule. As the German philosopher Hegel said, "The state says ... you must obey .... The state has rights against the individual; its members have obligations, among them that of obeying without protest" (Ralf Dahrendorf, Society and Democracy in Germany).

Look at how this tendency has manifested itself within today's Europe. The Lisbon Treaty—which in reality is the *constitution* for a revived European empire—defines those powers that the EU state holds over its members. Greece is but an early example of a country being brought to book by the EU centralized state. It will not be the last. (Even so, Greece has exposed deep divisions within the EU camp as its members have considered how to deal with it. Germany itself has been split over how to treat the issue. This again reflects the inherent weakness of current EU and German leadership.)

The member nations of the Germancreated EU imperial state have handed over their individual national sovereignty to the EU institutions. Constitutionally, the EU now wields tremendous power over its member states—with one singular exception: Germany. On the eve of the full ratification by all member states of the EU constitution, the German Constitutional Court rushed through a judgment that recognizes German law as trumping EU law. Thus Germany stands alone as not only the most dominant member of the European Union, but also as the only one that retains the power of its own sovereignty. While ensuring the loss of the very definition of the nationality of all other EU members, reducing them to vassal states of the European empire, the German elites have been careful to protect their own nationhood.

Now Germany possesses a legal,

political and economic power within Europe of an extent it never gained through past military aggression.

Meanwhile, those icons of past German heritage—the statues and memorials of pre-world war imperial glory brought back to the public gaze some years ago—remind the average German of an imperial national heritage. The nation possesses a latent national spirit that history proves only lacks at this moment the spark to light the fires of a revived nationalism.

### Four Things That Stir German Nationalism

Kurt P. Tauber, in his analysis of the German national character called Beyond Eagle and Swastika, analyzed and recorded the potency of the energy suddenly released from within Germany by the appeal of National Socialism in the 1920s and '30s. He also noted the latent nationalism bubbling under the surface in postwar Germany. In his conclusion, he mused, "We have analyzed the myriad difficulties and disappointments of postwar nationalism, but we strongly doubt that we have written its epitaph."

What have been the main stimulants to the rise of German nationalism in the past?

Four things: an *ideology* that appeals to the innate desires of German imperialism, the power of a *charismatic personality*, utilizing a compliant *cabal of industrialists*, and a powerful *cadre of military officers* to propel the nation to dominance in Europe.

In the 1930s, these stimulants were manifest through the ideology of National Socialism (Nazism), the personality of an Austrian by the name of Adolf Schicklegruber, the dynasties of German industrialists that produced his military machinery, and the powerful Prussian aristocratic military High Command that supported their führer's imperial vision.

Today, Nazism and Hitler are the whipping boys of German politicians and commentators who squarely blame the horrors of German extremism in World War II on both of them. This is a convenient way of absolving the German nation per se of any collective guilt.



Only two of those aforementioned stimulants to German nationalism are obviously extant today: those same dynasties of German industrialists (article, page 13), and a cadre of military officers modeled on the old German military High Command revived under the name Joint Operations Command.

That leaves us to wonder whether there exists a *personality* and a latent *ideology* that would have mass appeal to the German population such that it could unleash the dormant fires of German nationalism in a time of crisis as has been the habit of the German nation in the past.


We believe the answer to that is a clear and resounding *YES!* 

Let us consider personality first.

#### **Two Bavarians to Watch**

The *Trumpet* has noted two Bavarians who have the potential to powerfully in-





fluence Germany in times of crisis such as it has now entered.

Edmund Stoiber, mentored by the powerful postwar Bavarian politician Franz Josef Strauss, was the political leader who appeared likeliest to replace Gerhard Schröder as chancellor in Germany's 2002 federal election. But on the eve of the election, Schröder managed to swing the vote in his favor. Stoiber was narrowly defeated.

Then in 2005, it seemed Stoiber would gain the coveted foreign minister's job and hence the vice chancellorship in Chancellor Merkel's cabinet. But Merkel offered Stoiber the poisoned chalice of the economics portfolio. He declined and withdrew from the coalition—then became an eminent EU technocrat charged with slicing through the wasteful billions of euros of red tape in the EU bureaucracy.

Edmund Stoiber remains a powerful, if presently latent figure in German politics. He first garnered political strength from the years he spent as personal aide to Franz Josef Strauss. Then, as prime minister of Bavaria, he became renowned for running the most economically successful state in Germany. He is now in an interesting situation. Having presented his conclusions to the EU on methods to cut billions of euros of wastage out of the cumbersome and deeply corrupted EU

bureaucracy, he is in a prime position to be invited to consider a senior advisory post in the German government.

Stoiber has proven himself in the field of economics at the state level in Germany. But the plum job he sought in Germany's coalition government was the foreign policy portfolio. That is a ministerial post under great pressure for change as Vice Chancellor Westerwelle flounders. Stoiber, with his statesmanlike bearing, vast political experience and papal favor, would seem to be an ideal candidate for the foreign policy portfolio, if not a position as a chief adviser in this area.

Yet there is another Bavarian—mentored by Stoiber, even as Stoiber was previously by Strauss—who previously, though briefly, successfully filled the economics post in the Merkel government. He now heads up the defense portfolio in the Merkel coalition: Baron Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg.

This man's meteoric rise within German politics came about as a direct result of last September's elections. And the subsequent instability in the nation's ruling coalition has only bolstered his political profile all the more! Thus we track his progress with growing interest in light of Mr. Flurry's prediction regarding that election.

There is something almost dynastic about the Strauss-Stoiber-Guttenberg connection. Strauss penned the vision that all three hold of the future of Germany leading a united Europe in his visionary book *The Grand Design*.

In the conclusion to that book, Strauss admitted that Germany used the cloak of a postwar uniting Europe to hide behind

while undergoing its revival as a national power. He wrote, "[I]t was going to be much easier for Germany to make a comeback as a member of an international family, as a member of a European Federation, than as a German Reich, a single national state. Therefore we should not insist too much on what good Europeans we are; we must understand that our European attitude was the only escape hatch we had, the only approach that made a comeback possible."

Well, now Germany can play it both ways. It is a member—in fact the leading member—of a "European federation," the EU, having cleverly also retained its status as "a single nation state," the only nation to have done so within the entire 27-member union!

If we accept that Germany has two powerfully charismatic personalities that it can call upon in time of crisis to rally the nation, there is only one of the four previously mentioned elements that is lacking in the formula that has historically sparked the German people's innate nationalistic fervor: an *overarching ideology* preached by a revered icon.

Enter yet a third Bavarian.

#### **The Vatican Connection**

Franz Josef Strauss, Edmund Stoiber and Baron zu Guttenberg all exhibit one thing in common: dedication to Roman Catholicism. Bavaria is the heartland of Rome's religion in Germany. Coincidentally or otherwise, Bavaria's capital, Munich, was also the birthplace of the National Socialist movement in German politics back in the 1920s and '30s. It was in Munich that Hitler and Ludendorf initiated the famous Beer Hall Putsch in 1923.

Of all German states, Bavaria was the least denazified. It is said that from the mid-1940s through to the 1970s, Bavaria's government agencies and professions retained many of the same personalities in office as during the Nazi era. As they reached retirement age by the 1970s, they handed over to a generation they had taught and trained. Thus the National Socialist spirit remained alive, though cleverly masked under the veil of "democracy."

Amid that process there arose a third Bavarian who had lived through both those generations, a man now greatly revered in Germany: Joseph Ratzinger, Pope Benedict xvI.

Bavarian by birth, Benedict xvi's first visit back to his beloved Fatherland after he was elected pope was to the University of Regensburg in Bavaria where he had taught as a young priest. On that occasion, in a now infamous speech, he laid down the gauntlet to both the antichurch secularists and the entire Muslim community.

Over the five years of his papacy, Pope Benedict has proven himself the most articulate of modern popes, publishing a vast array of homilies, treatises and books. He is the archetypal conservative, right-wing and German to the core. He is backed by a strong rightist curia, the legacy of both his and his predecessor John Paul It's efforts to swing the church hierarchy away from its 20th-century liberal bent toward a more traditional "Holy Roman" orientation.

Benedict has a dogged determination to see his religion returned to its previous status as the force that binds the whole culture of Europe together. His vision is to see Europe, newly federalized under the Lisbon Treaty, return en masse to the religion that has bound imperial Europe together as the Holy Roman Empire in six previous resurrections since Justinian's restoration. Benedict knows that his home nation is the only power on Earth that can bring that about. He is, after all, an avid student of history.

James Bryce, in his work titled *The Holy Roman Empire*, notes that it is recorded in the *Speculum Saxonicum*, the great North German law book written in A.D. 1240, that

"The Empire is held [by] God alone .... Emperor and pope are supreme each in what has been entrusted to him: the pope in what concerns the soul; the emperor in all that belongs to the body and the knighthood." This was at the time of Frederick II, imperial ruler of the Holy Roman Empire.

The German Eike von Repgow, contemporary of Frederick II, stated in his

treatise *The Saxon Mirror* that "God has successfully created four empires and the present one is the continuation of the old Roman Empire. Caesar had conquered Germany, and the [German] Franks had then inherited the empire from the Romans" (Frederick Hertz, *The Development of the German Public Mind*). The

statement "God has successfully created four empires" is a reference to the four empires prophesied in Daniel 2:36-40, with the fourth kingdom being the iron kingdom that was to crush all others.

Of the later Habsburg dynasty, historian A.J.P. Taylor noted that the Holy Roman Empire of the time was "In the eyes of its rulers ... a supranational organization, ordained by God, and ruled over by God's nominee" (*The Habsburg Monarchy*).

Otto von Habsburg, of that same dynasty, referred to the symbol that Europe possesses which "belongs to all nations equally. This is the crown of the Holy Roman Empire, which embodies the tradition of Charlemagne .... [T]he crown represents not merely the sovereignty of the monarch, but also the ties between authority and the people" (The Social Order of Tomorrow). That crown represents the only power that has succeeded in binding Europe together in unity throughout history as a union of church and state: the Church of Rome and the German sovereign state! The crown of the Holy Roman Empire of the German Nation!

The EU *has* its ideology, even more potent than the now discredited National Socialism. It is a *religion* that has, over many centuries in the past, enlivened the whole nation with a religious zeal to crusade for the dominance of the Holy Reich

# **How Germany Solves Problems**

ISTORY demonstrates that it has been crises, often of the nation's own making, that have spurred the German people into action to impose very Germanic solutions to those crises.

Our friends at German-Foreign-Policy.com highlighted a recent classic case of this approach to crisis. It involved a couple of high-profile industrial agreements between France and Germany, the two nations that many have touted as underpinning true European unity.

For some time, France had limited Germany's effort in producing warships by stifling plans for a joint Franco-German effort to create a common European shipbuilding enterprise. The typical (and no doubt strategically motivated) French defiance over this deal led

to a crisis. This spurred one of the German companies involved, ThyssenKrupp, to "renounce civilian ship production to concentrate its dockyards solely on arms production. It is entering a 'strategic partnership' with the Abu Dhabi Mar Co. from the United Arab Emirates (UAE). Their deal seals the military alliance between Germany and the Emirates, possibly creating the opportunity for circumventing German arms exports regulations and ending efforts aimed at forging a German/French ship production ..." (Oct. 26, 2009; emphasis mine throughout). As German-Foreign-Policy .com observed, this just goes to show that "If a German-dominated 'European solution' cannot be accomplished, Berlin will do without 'Europe' and go it alone."

There you are! That's solving the crisis not the "European" way, but the German way! "According to the daily *Frankfurter Allgemeine* Zeitung, this means that the project of a common European maritime shipbuilding industry is 'as dead as a doornail.' As a matter of fact, the arms cooperation with the Gulf state was already cleared with the representatives of the Berlin government: 'We have sounded out all of the ministries and received a very positive prevailing sentiment,' ThyssenKrupp declared. Cooperation with the Emirates is 'far more sustainable than a European maritime company,' according to the German press, which usually never tires of praising 'Europe' and 'European solutions'-of course, only when German predominance in the

'European' project can be assured" (ibid.).

Yet another similar instance of Berlin's "my way or the highway" approach was its support of another German corporation caught in yet another Franco-German crisis. "Siemens recently terminated its nuclear cooperation with France, because Paris refused to give in to German demands for more influence in the nuclear sector, and began cooperation with Russia" (ibid.). Shades of the 1920s?

Both these reactions to similar crises depict Berlin's reversion to a well-tried strategy. The trend we are seeing in Berlin's reaction to any crisis facing the EU project is simply to impose the "German solution."

This reaction has historic overtones. It's a strategy enacted in over the whole world. It's a religion that inspired German soldiers with a crusading zeal in battle with the words "Gott mit uns"—God with us—embedded in their belt buckles as they fought in the trenches and in the desert in World War I.

#### **Gearing for Battle**

The Balkans provided the test case for public acceptance of the German military deploying in combat outside of the nation's borders when the Luftwaffe was drafted over Kosovo in 1999. Ten years later, the Bundeswehr operates in over a dozen countries around the world.

Even the Greens in Germany endorsed the Luftwaffe mission in the Balkans. Now, *Afghanistan* is providing the pressure point for German elites to begin conditioning the public's mind to accept an even wider and a stronger role for Germany in theaters of active or potential combat.

Since taking office last October after that pivotal election, Defense Minister Guttenberg has overseen certain changes in the government's stand on Germany's military force. He is spearheading changes to the Bundeswehr's rules of engagement in Afghanistan. Even months before that, Guttenberg had made it known that the public must be enticed to change its collective negative view of

German troop deployment in

Afghanistan so as to demonstrate public support of the nation's troops involved in active combat roles.

Guttenberg is determined to change the Bundeswehr's image into that of a legitimate combat force with broad public acceptance. At the February Munich Security Conference, he laid his cards on the table. He "spoke about the need to take action. What was important, the minister pointed out, was that progress be made regarding the long-overdue reforms of the United Nations and the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). 'We talk too much and act too little,'" he said (Munich Security Conference, February 6).

This was an effort to apply pressure to NATO to revamp its charter by the end of the year, implicitly integrating German imperial goals with NATO objectives. Guttenberg is particularly interested in eliminating overlap between the developing imperial European military force and NATO. Ultimately, German military elites will be eyeing either a merger with, or takeover of, the nuclear-armed NATO. This vision is helped by the fact that the majority of NATO members are overwhelmingly EU member nations. The EU is empowered under the Lisbon Treaty to develop a continental military force. That this force will have nuclear

potential is quietly taken as a given by certain German military and political elites.

Germany has come a long way since the Luftwaffe was the first Bundeswehr force to return to active combat outside of the nation's borders in the skies over Kosovo in 1999. Each step—from bombing runs over Kosovo to combat on the ground in Afghanistan; from arresting pirates in the Gulf to deployment in Sudan, Libya and Gabon, or securing the Mediterranean Sea and engaging in naval exercises off the coast of South Africa; from tank training in Canada and Luftwaffe training in the U.S.—is helping to finetune the Bundeswehr and make the public comfortable with its expeditionary roles.

It is important now to watch for the new NATO charter, which should be tabled by the end of this year. An appeasing Washington is being juggled out of the European sphere of influence. Europe's future security won't depend on an alliance with the U.S. Rather, it will be a forthcoming alliance between a Germanled European Union and—believe it or not—America's nemesis, Russia.

#### Where Is It All Leading?

The outcome of Germany's return to global power status is bound to amaze many

in the near future. Mr. Flurry's prediction of "devastating con-

cooperation with Berlin's traditional supporters, the German industrialists. A closer look at the Thyssen-Krupp example bears this out.

BACK IN THE WAR BUSINESS
ThyssenKrupp found itself suffering seriously because of the global economic crisis. Its response (having resulted in a €2 billion loss) was to consolidate its shipbuilding enterprises into one centralized operation, converting its whole operation to a war footing.

Berlin has been directly involved in supporting the ThyssenKrupp/Emirates deal. "The political ties between Berlin and the Arab feudal states are also being consolidated by the Gulf states' investments in the German economy" (ibid.). Financial Times Deutschland reported that, "Most recently, with a large financial transfusion, the Emirate of Qatar bought into Volkswagen, while the Aabar Investment Society of Abu

Dhabi bought into the Daimler car producer. Just last June, ThyssenKrupp's partner, the Abu Dhabi Mar Consortium, bought majority shares in the Nobiskrug Shipyard, which specializes in luxury ships, in Rendsburg, Germany" (ibid.).

This is Germany's more traditional approach to crisis: *imposing* the *German* solution. In each case, the solution has brought Germany closer, much closer, to militarizing its economy—something Germany's Defense Minister Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg has called for.

Berlin's cooperation with the UAE began not long after the Berlin Wall fell and Germany reunited. Five years ago, that cooperation was formalized by the signing of an Agreement of Cooperation in the Military Field. Since then, the Gulf states have increasingly

invested in the German economy and strengthened political ties with Berlin. To students of Bible prophecy, such an agreement has powerful overtones of a prophesied alliance (Psalm 83) between Germany and the oil-rich southern Arab states.

"Abu Dhabi's joining the German maritime shipbuilding industry signals *Berlin's fundamental* change of strategy in its long-term efforts to help bring the German arms industry to a position of predominance in Europe" (ibid.).

Germany is reverting to its historical militarized role in global politics. As Baron Guttenberg has declared, the time has come for Germany once again to merge *economic* policy with *military* policy. The result of this increasing pace in the militarization of the German economy will pale into stark insignificance the previous two occasions when Berlin adopted such a strategy.

## The German military-industrial complex went underground after the war, but it is back. BY ROBERT MORLEY

INCE WORLD WAR II, BUILDING UP large-scale defense companies has been taboo in Germany. But that taboo is now largely history.

Two of Germany's top military manufacturers—Rheinmetall and Man Group—have announced their intention to merge their military vehicle production. The resulting combine will produce a new

national champion and leading supplier for wheeled military vehicles in Europe.

This amalgamation, which has been in the works for a year, has been pushed by the political class. The German government is a big supporter of bulking up German military industry. MarketWatch columnist David Marsh said it "has been providing behind-the-scenes assistance

to make sure industry goes in the right direction." The new combine "meets the long-held German desire to build industrial companies with world scale in the defense field" (January 18).

Anyone who knows the history of Rheinmetall and Man should be alarmed.

Rheinmetall has been at the forefront of German military manufacturing for over a century, so it isn't too surprising that it again became a weapons builder after the World War II loss. In fact, despite the Allies' initial ban on arms production, Rheinmetall was back mass-producing machine guns by 1956. By 1972, Rheinmetall had developed and begun selling the Leopard 2 battle tank.

Not much later, and after a series of corporate acquisitions, Rheinmetall became Europe's leading military supplier of systems and equipment for ground forces, providing everything from artillery and munitions to communications, surveillance technology and guided missile systems. Rheinmetall subsidiaries, which also include significant automotive component manufacturers, are located throughout Europe, the Americas and China.

Man Group's 252-year history is even more impressive. Man is one of Europe's leading manufacturers of commercial vehicles, engines and mechanical engineering equipment. Man builds trucks, buses, diesel engines and turbo-machinery; it also provides industrial services. During World War II, and in conjunction with Rheinmetall, Man produced the hugely successful Panther tank. Following the war, Man took over notorious World War II light vehicle manufacturer Büssing. According to Man's website, the corporation holds "leading market positions in all its business areas," employing 50,000 people worldwide.

But the real reason the Rheinmetall-Man Group alliance should be thoroughly scrutinized stems from a historic meeting the *Trumpet* has often drawn attention to.

#### **Germany's Plan to Return**

According to a top-secret document the U.S. government declassified in 1996, several of Germany's largest industrial giants and top German officials met on Aug. 10, 1944, just nine months before World War It's end. Among them were corporate leaders representing Krupp, Volkswagenwerk, Messerschmitt, *Rheinmetall*, Rochling, Büssing and other companies. Top German military and political personnel from the SS, Navy, and the Ministries of Armaments told them to prepare for a "postwar commercial campaign" after the

eventual German loss.
They must, the document said, "through their exports increase the strength of Germany." They were in-

structed to place existing financial reserves at the disposal of the Nazi Party "so that a strong German empire can be created after the defeat."

This document highlighted the exact worry that the Allies tried to address by seeking to destroy Germany's future warmaking capability. Franklin Roosevelt and Winston Churchill said, "It is our inflexible purpose to ... ENSURE that Germany will

NEVER AGAIN be able to disturb the peace of the world. We are determined to ... break up for all time the German General Staff that has *repeatedly* contrived the resurgence of German militarism; ... eliminate or control *all German industry* that could be used for military production ..."

It is now blatantly evident that they failed! Both Rheinmetall and Man Group (Büssing), which were named in the declassified report, have become dominant players on the world stage again. And Germany has become the world's largest exporting nation and fourth-largest economy.

But a look at the astounding post-World

War II success of the other above-mentioned four companies identified in the document not only suggests a postwar German commercial campaign, but a highly effective one.

#### **Astonishing Industrial Rebound**

Take steel and weapons manufacturer Krupp (now ThyssenKrupp). When Germany lost World War II, the company was forbidden by the Allies to manufacture arms (as it was after World War I); Alfried Krupp, the company's owner, was convicted of war crimes, including the use of mass slave labor. He was sentenced to 12 years

## Crank Up the Defense Industry

LOBAL summits are generally worthless. January's World Economic Forum at Davos, Switzerland, was no exception—except for a startling announcement from a German official.

Dow Jones reported the news: "Germany's government launched an initiative to strengthen its military industry during the World Economic Forum this weekend in the latest sign that the country has become emboldened to fight for its international interests" (January 31).

Germany's defense minister, Karl-Theodor zu Guttenberg, used Davos as the occasion to announce that Germany is commencing an aggressive development of its defense industry! "A group of top executives from German blue chips met with federal ministers, talking military business in Davos," this report said. At a breakfast meeting with leaders of several companies, Guttenberg brought up the "necessary interplay of defense policy and Germany's economic interests," according to his spokesman.

For anyone who had memories of the last time that a united Germany revived an ailing economy by cranking up the wheels of industry to produce instruments of war, this should have set the alarm bells ringing! But no—to

the contrary. The announcement was greeted with words of approval.

Jackson Janes, executive director of the Washington-based think tank the American Institute for Contemporary German Studies, warmly declared, "Germany has come a long way since unification toward expeditionary activities including, but not only in, Afghanistan. Think of the Balkans" (ibid.).

Yes! THINK of the Balkans! There Germany lit the fuse that started the Balkan wars of the 1990s, cleverly then handing the resultant explosion to the U.S./NATO axis to fight an illegal war on its behalf. In the process, Germany willingly joined the battle by sending a belligerent force via the Luftwaffe to join NATO bombing raids over the Balkan Peninsula in 1999.

Ten years later, with the Bundeswehr now deployed in 13 countries, the German defense minister announces at Davos, to plaudits from the West, that the *Deutschlanders* are once again aggressively cranking up their industry to produce weapons and machinery of war! And this time it's with the *encouragement* of the Anglo-Saxons, who, less than a century ago, fought a war, initiated by Germany, to determine, in the words of the Allied leaders.



that the German military would never, ever again pose a threat to global freedom!

The move is being backed by Washington, which has long been pushing Germany to take more responsibility for global security and defense.

But the German elites are faced with one small problem: a German public whose mind has been conditioned to *non-aggression*. Witness the extreme unpopularity of the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, the latter being a theater where Germany provides the third-largest contingent of troops in the NATO/ISAF force.

But the German political elites are taking this all in their stride. Startlingly, Germany's Economics Minister Rainer Bruderle added to the announcement of stepped-up German militarization by giving more than a hint that propaganda would prevail to ensure that the mind of the German public would

be conditioned to support this latest aggressive policy change by Berlin. Dow Jones reported Bruderle as asserting, in words just too reminiscent of the 1930s: "Germans are still a little bit shy in this domain, but we'll work to change this too"!

For the past 20 years since the Berlin Wall came down, the *Trumpet* has been watching for, and predicting, these very events. Now they are rapidly becoming a reality. Today, under a continuance of appeasing 20th-century governments in Washington and London, misled by a facade of democracy that masks the true intentions of German elites, America endorses the revving up of the German military machine. in prison and ordered to forfeit all his property. Later, however, the U.S. high commissioner for Germany granted him amnesty and restored much of his holdings. Alfried Krupp was released in the early part of 1951, and even though many of the Krupp factories, shipyards and steel and coal mines had been damaged, destroyed or dismantled, Krupp was still able to reestablish itself as a leading German company by the 1960s to continue its 100-year tradition of supplying Germany with the arms needed for war.

The speed at which ThyssenKrupp reestablished itself as a corporate giant was astonishing.

Today, ThyssenKrupp is one of the largest steel and technology groups in the world, employing about 184,000 workers in more than 70 countries. It is also a leading naval military supplier, building some of the most technologically advanced submarines, frigates and corvettes available. Its fiscal 2004/2005 sales of approximately \$53.3 billion were generated in bulk from its roughly 600 foreign subsidiary companies, located in the UK, France, Italy and 13 other European countries. ThyssenKrupp also has operations in the United States and Asia. Not bad for a company that was all but destroyed in two world wars.

Volkswagen, another German corporation documented for its collusion with the World War II Nazis, has become a globally dominant automotive power. Though its core market is the European Union, Volkswagen sales make it the world's third-largest automotive company by revenue. Volkswagen owns the Bentley brand; international vehicle manufacturer Audi; Seat and Skoda, which manufacture and sell cars in Spain and in southern and Eastern Europe; and Lamborghini, which makes sports cars in Italy.

Messerschmitt, Germany's famous World War II manufacturer that built much of the Luftwaffe's fighting aircraft, is also prospering today, though under a different name. Like Krupp, much of Messerschmitt's infrastructure was destroyed in the war. Further, Messerschmitt was even forbidden to produce aircraft. Yet it



too has risen to become part of a world-leading corporation. Messerschmitt was eventually allowed to build aircraft again, and in 1989, after several postwar mergers, Messerschmitt became part of Daimler-Benz Aerospace (another German industrial giant). Daimler-Benz Aerospace then later helped found the European Aeronautic Defense and Space Company (EADS), becoming a 30 percent owner.

EADS today is a global aerospace and defense technology leader. The group includes the aircraft manufacturer Airbus, and the world's largest helicopter supplier, Eurocopter. It is also a major shareholder in MBDA, the international leader in missile systems. EADS produces the Eurofighter and other military aircraft. Galileo, the European satellite navigation system being constructed to rival the U.S.'s GPS, is also being built in large part by EADS. The company employs 113,000 people at more than 70 production sites, primarily in France, Germany, Great Britain and Spain.

Rochling, founded 184 years ago as a coal-trading house, has now become a leader in high-performance plastics technologies. In 2004, the Rochling Group's worldwide operations generated revenue of approximately \$1.78 billion and employed 8,000 workers.

Yes, Germany's war machine is back in fighting order.

#### **Just as Predicted**

While Germany was but a pile of rubble after World War II, one man—Herbert W.

Armstrong—warned that Germany would eventually rise again to dominate Europe and threaten the world.

As early as 1945, broadcasting during a United Nations conference, Mr. Armstrong warned that German industry was working toward the revival of a German empire. "We don't understand German thoroughness," he said. "From the very start of World War II, they have considered the possibility of losing this second round, as they did the first—and they have carefully, methodically planned, in such eventuality, the third round: World War III!"

"What most do not know," said Mr. Armstrong, "is that the Germans have their plans for winning the BATTLE of the peace. Yes, I said BATTLE of the peace."

# **Swans Make Final Landing**

The sound of diesel motors, hydraulic pistons, power tools and voices brought the Armstrong Auditorium work site to life the morning of March 9, just before the day's most important piece of equipment arrived: a 100-ton crane. The crane would make possible the auditorium's interior and exterior centerpieces: three crystal chandeliers and *Swans in Flight*, a sculpture by Sir David Wynne.

As the crane began hoisting equipment to the roof of the auditorium, the work site quickly became the center of attention of workers on the site and in the adjacent offices where the *Trumpet* is produced. By 10 a.m., the crew had set the hoist apparatus that will be used to secure three important parts of the Armstrong Auditorium lobby: two 10-foot side chandeliers and one 12-foot center chandelier. Then the crew repositioned the crane and began to secure lifting slings and straps to the birds.

Swans in Flight was commissioned by Herbert Armstrong—after whom Armstrong Auditorium is named—in the late 1960s. Renowned British sculptor David Wynne created the piece for the Ambassador College campus in Big Sandy, Texas. The iconic form depicts the five stages of a swan in flight. Wynne was knighted in 1994 by Queen Elizabeth II for his body of work, which includes Boy With Dolphin near the Tower Bridge in London and the royal seal on the gates of Hyde Park honoring the Queen Mother's 90th birthday in 1992. Wynne's work appears all over the world and includes numerous commissions by the royal family.

After Mr. Armstrong died, Ambassador College eventually failed, and the campus was sold. The campus's new owner, the Institute in Basic Life Principles, subsequently announced that the Wynne sculpture was for sale.

Gerald Flurry, editor in chief of the *Trumpet* and pastor general of the Philadelphia Church of God, authorized the purchase of the sculpture in April 2009. The sculpture was disassembled at Big Sandy on August 11 and transported to a foundry in Norman, Oklahoma. After repairing the sculpture and applying a refinished patina, the foundry delivered the birds to the PCG campus in January 2010, where they awaited installation.

After the crane operator relocated four of the birds, the heaviest of which weighs approximately 1,600 pounds, the crane swung back to bring the final stage—the swan with its wings in an upstroke—into place at the top of the sculpture, about 12 feet off the ground.

As he waited for the foundry workers and his crew to unsling the bird, crane operator Rick Church commented about the sculpture. Church, who has worked cranes for 15 years throughout Oklahoma and Texas, said he looked forward to seeing the finished product, which will feature a 120-foot reflecting pool and water jets spraying toward the birds, simulating motion. "I've seen a lot of fountains," he said over the growl of the crane's idling diesel engine. "But you've got something real special here. This is rare."

The swan sculpture will be unveiled by David Wynne at Armstrong Auditorium's official grand opening ceremony this summer.

### **EUROPE**

Europe is waiting for a decisive answer from Germany on what to do with Greece. On February 3, European Economic and Monetary Affairs Commissioner Joaquin Almunia announced that he would take the unprecedented step of monitoring the Greek government's spending. However, apart from issuing vague promises that Greece will not go bust, Europe has not revealed its plan of action. The European Union, however, has jumped on the chance to give itself more powers. It took the unprecedented step of denying Greece its right to vote at an EU meeting in March as a show of disapproval. It has also threatened to invoke Article 126.9 of the Lisbon Treaty, which would force Greece to follow the EU's program of taxation and spending in order to cut its deficit.

The Dutch government collapsed on February 20 over a disagreement within the ruling coalition over the country's participation in the **Afghanistan** war. The Labor Party wanted to keep its campaign promise and bring all Dutch troops home; its coalition partners, the Christian Democrats in the CDA and CD, wanted to leave 500 to 600 soldiers in the country as per NATO's request. Queen Beatrix of the Netherlands ordered a new election for June 9. One



of the biggest beneficiaries will probably be Geert Wilders and his right-wing anti-Islamic Freedom Party. Opin-



ion polls indicate the Party for Freedom would increase its number of seats in the 150-strong parliament from 9 to 24—making it the secondlargest party after the Christian Democrats. During local elections at the beginning of March, Wilders's party came first in one of the two cities where it fielded candidates, and second in the other. Wilders could well be a member of the next government. Watch for more such successes as Europe's citizens turn further against Islam and immigration.

The Catholic and Orthodox churches must unite in order to defend Europe's Christian roots, Pope Benedict XVI told a group of Romanian bishops on February 12. As the bishops concluded their regular consultation with the pope, Benedict emphasized the need for them to work with their Orthodox counterparts. This

came less than a fortnight after the pope admonished English and Welsh bishops to be generous toward any Anglicans wishing to return to Rome. The Catholic, Protestant and Orthodox churches are all coming together.

The Catholic Church has been hit by another massive sex scandal, this time in Germany. Around 100 priests and members of the laity are suspected of abuse. "[T]he wall of silence is coming down here in Germany," wrote Spiegel Online. "It started when Berlin's Canisius College, an elite Jesuit high school, recently disclosed the sordid past of a number of members of the order who had abused students at the school in the 1970s and 1980s. After that, new victims began coming forward on a daily basis. ... A tremor is currently passing through the Catholic Church in Germany" (February 8).

**Tran** CELEBRATED THE 31ST anniversary of Ayatollah Khomeini's Islamic Revolution on February 11, with large-scale rallies in Tehran and across the country. At the same time, security forces cracked down on anti-government protesters holding opposition rallies.

Meanwhile, on February 7, President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad ordered his atomic chief to enrich uranium to a higher, weapons-grade level of purity. Tehran says it is now enriching uranium to 20 percent.

Additionally, Japanese intelligence sources have revealed that a North Korean shipment of 45 tons of yellowcake—enough for several nuclear bombs—that was orig-



inally bound for **Syria** before **Israel** struck a plutonium plant under construction there in 2007, was reshipped to Iran two years later. DEBKA*file* said this revelation suggests Tehran may be secretly hoarding even more enriched uranium from black-market sources.

President Ahmadinejad and other Iranian officials met with Syrian and Hezbollah leaders in Damascus on February 25. Ahmadinejad also had a meeting with leaders of Palestinian terrorist organizations Hamas and Islamic Jihad.

Iran and the Persian Gulf state of **Qatar** signed a memorandum of understanding for defense cooperation on February 24. The fact that Qatar, an ally of the U.S. in its war on terror, is actually strengthening defense ties with the biggest state sponsor of terror demonstrates the unreliable nature of America's "moderate" Arab allies.

Iran continues to interfere in **Iraq**. On February 16, America's commanding

general in Iraq, Gen. Ray Odierno, revealed that the two politicians who organized the banning of about 500 Sunni candidates from running in Iraq's March 7 elections were linked to Iran's Revolutionary Guard Corps. Earlier in the month an appeals

panel lifted the ban, a decision that was subsequently overruled by Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki, despite U.S. Vice President Joe Biden urging Iraqi officials to reconsider. The Maliki government blasted the U.S. for interfering, illustrating just how weak America's influence in Iraq has become—and how strong Iran's. As a result, a major Sunni political bloc, the National Dialogue Front, said it would boycott the election.

On the economic front, Iran is seeking to double its trade with Iraq to \$8 billion this year, an Iranian official said February 21. Iran is Iraq's largest trade partner, and has been the biggest investor in its Shiite neighbor since 2003.

Lebanese Prime Minister Saad Hariri has stated that the Lebanese government will officially support Hezbollah in any future conflict with Israel. "I think they're betting that there might be some division in **Lebanon**, if there is a war against us," Hariri said in an interview with the BBC, published on February 10. "Well, there won't be a division in Lebanon. We will stand against Israel. We will stand with our own people." Hariri has been considered a moderate in the past—before

capitulating to Hezbollah and its Syrian and Iranian sponsors.

Just two days after Hariri's statement, the U.S. announced a boost in military aid to Lebanon. U.S. Defense Secretary Robert Gates said the U.S. would provide Lebanon \$267 million in military aid. Of course, as U.S. think tank Stratfor points out, "If the United States were to train and equip the Lebanese military, it would run the very real risk of having those trained individuals and all that equipment fall into the hands of one of the many militant groups operating out of Lebanon" (February

17). To avoid this scenario, the U.S. offer reportedly included the development and training of an elite army unit separate from the main Lebanese military, specifically to combat Hezbollah. However, there is no guarantee that Hezbollah would not be able to infiltrate such a force, just as it has the Lebanese Army. The U.S.'s desperation in trying to undercut Hezbollah is evident in that to do so, it is increasing military aid to a government that is openly promising to support the terrorist group in any conflict with Israel.

### **ASIA**

HOUSANDS OF ANGRY citizens from across Japan marched through the streets of Tokyo on January 30 to protest the continued U.S. military presence on Okinawa. At present, around 47,000 U.S. soldiers are stationed throughout Japan, more than half of them at the Futenma Air Station on Okinawa. Claiming the U.S. military base is a major source of noise, pollution and crime, a growing number of Japanese are demanding it be removed. In 2006, Tokyo and Washington agreed to relocate the facility to a less-populated area on Okinawa, but polls show a majority of Japanese want a total end to the U.S. military presence in Japan. The pressure on Prime Minister Yukio Hatoyama is not just coming from the public. Mizuho Fukushima, who leads Hatoyama's coalition partner, the Social Democratic Party (SDP), said her party may quit the coalition if Japan allows the U.S. to stay in Okinawa. Without the SDP, Hatoyama would be unable to pass legislation. This protest was just another of many indications of a change in the relationship between the U.S. and Japan. The U.S. can no longer count

on Japan's support.

The new leader of **Ukraine**, Viktor Yanukovych, has begun the process of rebuilding Kiev's relationship with Moscow. Even before he was sworn in on February 25, Yanukovych announced several pro-Russian defense policies and said NATO integration would no longer be a goal for Ukraine. He declared his support for the Kremlin's plan to create a post-NATO European security treaty and renewed a call for a Russianled consortium to take ownership of Ukraine's strategic gas transit pipeline network. In response, Russia announced a resumption of diplomatic ties with Ukraine. The message is clear: Yanukovych owes his power and position to the Kremlin, and Moscow expects Ukraine to begin cooperating more wholeheartedly. Rather than launching a "hot" war, Russia has clearly waged a campaign of intimidation, subversion and propaganda. The more pro-European western part of Ukraine may still give the Kremlin some trouble, but the east (and the national government) is now firmly in Russia's grasp.

China expanded its lead as the world's foremost agricultural producer in 2008 with its food production jumping 30 percent, according to a February 23 note by the World Trade Organization (WTO) secretariat. It is another sign of an unmistakable trend:

China continues to grow as an economic powerhouse.

China and Russia spoke out in early March against levying harsher United Nations sanctions on Iran, maintaining that negotiations are the best way to resolve concerns over Tehran's nuclear program. France, Germany, the U.S. and the UK have presented China and Russia with a proposed set of sanctions targeting Iran's banking, shipping and Revolutionary Guards Corps. In the coming months, China and Russia are sure to continue to complicate the West's plans with their reluctance to support any substantial action against Iran.

Beijing and Moscow arrived at an initial agreement on March 4 for a pricing formula for the supply of Russian natural gas to China whereby the price of the gas will be connected to oil prices. Some of the details of the agreement are still undetermined, but talks are progressing quickly. The Xinhua News Agency reported on shortages of fuel used for heating in several Chinese cities during last year's especially cold winter; the shortages ended after China imported natural gas from Central Asia. Beijing wants to ensure it has sufficient supplies throughout the country this year. Watch for Russia and China to continue to cozy up together economically as a precursor to military alliance.

### LATIN AMERICA/ AFRICA

rgentina is once again Apushing its claim to the Falkland Islands. British firms have begun exploring for oil around the Falklands, prompting an angry response from Argentina. The drilling is "illegitimate" and a "violation of our sovereignty," said Argentine Foreign Minister Jorge Taiana, promising that "we will do everything possible to defend and preserve our rights." On February 11, Argentine authorities boarded a ship they claimed was transporting pipes to the Falklands for the oil excavations. On February 16, the government announced it would prevent ships from traveling through Argentine waters to the Falklands, prompting the Royal Navy to stand by to protect ships traveling there.

U.S. Secretary of State Hillary Clinton handed Argentina a major diplomatic victory on March 2 by backing its demands for negotiation with Britain over the Falklands at the UN. This was a major insult to Britain, and further proof of what the Trumpet has been writing for some months now: that the British and American "special relationship" is over. "This was a spectacular slap in the face for America's closest ally," wrote the Telegraph, "at a time when thousands of British troops are fighting alongside the United States on the battlefields of Afghanistan" (March 3). "British possession of these islands has meant British control of one of the great sea gates of the world," wrote Herbert W. Armstrong in 1982. "God prophesied that, because of disobedience, we should lose these islands in this end time. All have been lost except these Falkland Islands, Gibraltar,



Hong Kong and some other incidental islands" (member and coworker letter, April 21, 1982). Now Hong Kong is gone. The EU threatens Gibraltar. Watch for Britain to lose the Falklands soon—either to Argentina, or the EU.

The EU plans to

restart talks with
Mercosur, the Latin
American trade bloc,
this year to cement a
free-trade agreement.
Mercosur, led by Argentina and Brazil, was
engaged in talks with the EU
for such a deal in early 2008,
but the discussions stalled.
The Plain Truth magazine
forecast in May 1962, "[T]he

gantic trade blocs, Europe and

Latin America, mesh together

and begin calling the shots in

world commerce.'

Few nations would celebrate the birthday of despotextraordinaire **Robert Mugabe**. Yet on February 21, China threw the Zimbabwean president a party at its embassy in Harare to celebrate his 86th birthday. China is hungry for resources and has no qualms about dealing with genocidal

dictators to get them. Chinese troops have been seen walking the streets of one of **Zimbabwe**'s biggest cities. Asia and Europe are destined to become locked in a fierce competition over Africa's resources.

All companies operating in Zimbabwe that have over \$500,000 worth of assets must be at least 51 percent owned by "indigenous" Zimbabweans—or blacks—by 2015, according to a law that went into force March 1. The companies affected have 45 days to send the government a plan



of how they will accomplish this. Violently removing farm owners from their land has led to catastrophic famines in Zimbabwe. Doing the same thing to business will make things even worse.

The South African ANC-led government continues to show solidarity with Iran even as the West grapples with trying to stop the Islamic Republic from becoming a nuclear threat. **South Africa**'s Speaker of Parliament Max Sisulu met with his Iranian counterpart, Ali Larijani, in Tehran on January 23. Additionally, South Africa has been cultivating a close relationship with Russia. These two countries together

possess most of the world's strategic minerals—some 90 percent of them. Back in 1997, we wrote in our booklet South Africa in Prophecy, "[I]f an African National Congress (ANC)-South African Communist Party

(SACP)-dominated government in South Africa forges links with the Islamic-Arab crescent in consortium with Russia, only those who bow to radical Islam and a Communist-led ANC may get their raw materials!" The relationship between South Africa and Iran is one to watch.

### ANGLO-AMERICA

N FEBRUARY 1, THE U.S. Defense Department officially scrapped its two-war doctrine. In the past, the **United States** military has been prepared to simultaneously fight two major conventional wars single-handedly. However, the new Quadrennial Defense Review focuses on non-state threats and reliance on allies, stating, "The United States cannot sustain a stable international system alone."

Also in early February, Congress approved the federal government to go into debt by \$1.9 trillion more. The vote increased the notional cap on federal debt to \$14.3 trillion.

On February 18, a Texas man intentionally crashed his single-engine airplane into a government building in Austin, Texas, killing an employee of the Internal Revenue Service, which he was targeting. Less than a month later, a California man dressed in a suit and carrying two semiautomatic weapons calmly walked up to two police officers at the Pentagon and shot them both before being killed in return fire.

News sources reported in February that American forces in Iraq will cease all combat operations on September 1

and transfer all operations to Iraqi forces. Although last year was the third-deadliest for U.S. troops in Iraq, the war has slipped from headlines and from the president's priority list. President Barack Obama, who campaigned on a promise

to pull U.S. troops from Iraq, has only mentioned the war, in passing, three times in his formal speeches, focusing instead on domestic issues such as health care. As the *Trumpet* has long forecast, America's involvement in Iraq—and its withdrawal—will only lead to a takeover by Iran.

The Canadian press reported that a new study revealed the average Canadian family's debt climbed to CAN\$96,100 in 2009. The survey found the average debt-to-income ratio at 145 percent, the highest ratio recorded by the 11-year-old study.

A February Ofgem report estimated that although energy bills for British consumers have doubled over the past six years, they could rise another 25 percent by 2020. The survey also revealed the nation's energy security situation is deteriorating as fast as its North Sea reserves. By 2015, **Britain** will be importing three quarters of its gas, which it relies on to generate 40 percent of its electricity and to heat almost every British home.

A February poll found that most British voters believe they are living in a "broken Britain." Nearly three out of five said they hardly recognize their country, and are deeply pessimistic. The survey showed that 42 percent admitted they want to emigrate.



ter has risen dramatically over the past 20 years. To close observers of current events in relation to both history and Bible prophecy, this is no mere coincidence. What muddies the water as soon as biblical prophecy is mentioned in relation to natural disaster is the fact that there is a literal abundance of kooks, screwballs and fanatics out there who instantly seize on the latest catastrophe to declare "the end is nigh."

Doomsayers have been doing this for years. Far too many get involved in such activity for personal profit. They peddle their scaremongering by taking advantage of vulnerable people and, for a price, promise to show a way that the gullible can escape the wrath of their god, the next disaster, creatures from outer space,

the end of the world, the implosion of the universe or some other such wacky idea. They make it doubly hard for the genuine seeker after truth.

The facts are that statistics prove natural disasters have risen startlingly since 1990. In a law-abiding universe, there has to be a reason for this.

#### **Deadly Increase**

During the 40 years preceding the decade of the 1990s, there were 142 classified natural disasters in the United States. During the 10 years of the 1990s, there were 72. The decade that followed from 2000 to 2009 saw some of the worst and most destructive natural disasters in recorded history across the globe. And the most destructive in terms of loss of life and property? Earthquakes by far!

"Earthquakes are the deadliest natural hazard of the past 10 years and remain a serious threat for millions of people worldwide as eight out of the ten most populous cities in the world are on earthquake fault lines,' said Margareta Wahlström, UN special representative of the secretary general for disaster risk reduction. ...

"According to the figures released today by CRED [the Center for Research on Epidemiology of Disasters] in Geneva, 3,852 disasters killed more than 780,000 people over the past 10 years, affected more than 2 billion others and cost a minimum of USS960 billion....

"After earthquakes, storms (22 percent) and extreme temperatures (11 percent) were the most deadly disasters between 2000 and 2009. ... 'The number of catastrophic events has more than doubled since the



1980-1989 decade,' [said] Professor Guha-Sapir, director of CRED" (United Nations International Strategy for Disaster Reduction Secretariat press release, January 28).

The current decade has commenced with early indications of that trend continuing. Devastating earthquakes in Haiti, Chile and Turkey, along with recordbreaking winter storms in Europe and North America, have left many dead and homeless, and greatly damaged town and city infrastructures.

On reflection, clearly 1989 was a watershed year, a threshold from which natural disasters escalated most dramatically compared to past eras in history.

Why such drastic escalation in natural disasters since 1989—earthquakes, tsunamis, destructive storms, floods, fires, mudslides, extremes of temperatures—which take the figures right off the record charts since statistics have been recorded?

Well, there is a reason. But it is only apparent to those who, in unbiased, clear-minded fashion, link the facts on the ground with the history of the past and the reality of inerrant Bible prophecies for the future.

#### **No More Delay**

There is a prophecy in your Bible that speaks of the world reaching a time when catastrophic events prophesied by humanity's Creator-which were once delayed in their fulfillment for a great purpose-would no longer be held back by the hand of God. # Where Did Christ's Apostles Go?

## After Acts 11, little is mentioned about their whereabouts. But the truth about their travels unlocks a marvelous mystery! BY STEPHEN FLURRY

OST PEOPLE MISUNDERSTAND prophecy because they can't IDENTIFY the modern-day descendants of ancient *Israel*—the 10 tribes that revolted against King Rehoboam's burdensome regime.

When the 10 northern tribes seceded, they selected Jeroboam as their king, moved their capital from Jerusalem to Samaria and retained "Israel" as their namesake. The two southern tribes, headquartered in Jerusalem, became known as *Judah*.

During Shalmaneser's three-year siege of Samaria in the eighth century B.C., the Assyrians uprooted the Israelites from their homeland and deported them as slaves into the land of Assyria, then located between the Euphrates River and the southern shores of the Caspian Sea (see 2 Kings 17:23-24).

After this event, many historians and scholars lose track of the Israelites. Some assume that the 10 tribes vanished from off the Earth!

But they didn't disappear. They just lost their identity, as Jesus plainly confirmed a full EIGHT CENTURIES later.

#### "The Lost Sheep of Israel"

As a direct descendant of King David, of the tribe of Judah, Jesus had been born in a Jewish colony that was subordinate to the Roman Empire. "He came unto his own," it says in John 1:11, "and his own received him not."

The Jews rejected Jesus and so He turned to the Gentiles instead, some assume. But he didn't! Notice what Jesus said to a Gentile woman in Matthew 15:24: "I was not sent *except* to the LOST sheep of the house of Israel" (New King James Version).

What an illuminating scripture! In one simple verse, Jesus said His mission was to reach the house of Israel (not the house of Judah) and that Israel's identity (obviously

not Judah's) had become LOST.

How then—since Christ's life was cut short soon after He made that statement—was that divine mission fulfilled? Read it yourself in Matthew 10:5-6. In that account, Jesus *commanded* His disciples NOT to preach the gospel in Gentile regions (Paul would take care of that—see Acts 18:6), but to go instead to the "lost sheep" of the house of Israel.

In Jesus's stead, *all the original apostles* were SENT to the lost sheep of Israel.

This is why, after Acts 11, you read very little about the original 12. Once they went to the lost sheep of Israel, history lost sight of them.

And that's the way God wanted it! It wasn't *time* for Israel's identity to be revealed to the world.

#### "The Twelve Tribes, Scattered Abroad"

Notice the way the Apostle James introduced his epistle: "James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting." James didn't even address the Gentiles. Nor is his letter exclusively directed at the house of Judah. His target audience was primarily the tribes of Israel that had been "scattered abroad" during their Assyrian captivity eight centuries earlier!

God could have easily inspired James to include more details about the whereabouts of the lost sheep. But He didn't want their identity revealed yet. So the book of James ends without any closing salutations about the people he was writing to. It's one of just three New Testament books (the others are Acts and 3 John) that abruptly finishes without so much as an "Amen"!

In the content of James, however, there is one important clue that sheds light on the location of the lost sheep during the first century. It's in James 4:1: "From whence come wars and fightings among

you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members?" While this passage has a spiritual application that applies to God's people today, in James's day, he was speaking about literal wars that were raging in the areas where Israelites had been scattered.

James wrote his book around A.D. 60, about 10 years *before* the Roman Empire sacked Jerusalem. It was a relatively peaceful time in the world, with Rome towering above regional powers. At the time, Rome was engaged in just two major skirmishes—one *in Britain* and the other in Parthia, located around the southern shores of the Caspian Sea!


These were the wars going on "among" the Israelites James addressed. What a fascinating bit of evidence as to Israel's whereabouts!

#### "An Immense Multitude"

Parthia has an intriguing history. The Parthians suddenly appeared around the Caspian shores soon after the people of Israel had been exiled there as slaves in the eighth century B.C. According to historian George Rawlinson, the name Parthia means "exile."

In fact, these exiles who rose to power and prominence in the land of Parthia around 250 B.C. were none other than the "lost" tribes of Israel! They remained in the land of their captivity until the early part of the third century A.D., when the Persians drove them northwest into what is Europe today.

Josephus, the prominent first-century Jewish historian, was well aware of Israel's settlement into the land of Parthia. In his history about the days of Ezra and the construction of the second temple, Josephus declared, "But then the entire body of the people of Israel [the lost sheep] remained in that country [they never returned to Samaria]; wherefore there are but two tribes



in Asia and Europe subject to the Romans, while the 10 tribes are *beyond Euphrates* till now, and are an IMMENSE MULTITUDE, and not to be estimated by numbers" (emphasis mine).

So much for disappearing! Evidently, the multitude of scattered Israelites was so immense that Jesus commanded Peter, James, John and the rest of His disciples to go to these "lost sheep." If you have a collection of maps at the back of your Bible, look at the one that illustrates Paul's territory. He was the apostle in charge of the Gentile region. His area basically covers northern Palestine and every region that touches the northern border of the Mediterranean Sea, including what is today southern Turkey, Greece and Italy. He also pastored congregations on the islands of Malta, Crete and Cyprus. And in Romans 15:24, Paul said he intended to visit Spain as well.

That is a HUGE territory! But not as large as the regions the "lost sheep" of Israel had been scattered into. Those territories, remember, had been reserved for the original 12. And there was very little territorial

overlap, as Paul confirmed in Romans 15:20. Paul worked in his assigned territory—and the other apostles worked in theirs.

#### "Strangers Scattered"

Now consider Peter's jurisdiction. One of his regions, judging by the opening remarks in his first epistle, was *northern* Turkey. "Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the *strangers* scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia." Peter didn't use the word "strangers" in the sense that they were Gentiles. It comes from a Greek word that means *resident foreigner* or *alien*.

Peter was fulfilling his Christ-given commission. He was addressing Israelite "strangers" who were dwelling in Gentile lands. And where? Throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia and Bithynia (see map). Whereas *Paul* was expressly forbidden to enter the northern half Turkey (Acts 16:6-7), Peter was commanded to reach the multitude of "lost sheep" that had been scattered in that area.

Just as there was an immense multitude

of "lost sheep" to be reached beyond the Euphrates in the land of Parthia, so there was another multitude—one that Josephus was unaware of—that had migrated northwest of Samaria into the region of northern Turkey.

And these are the territories we can pinpoint after examining just two epistles, written by two of the original 12 disciples.

Think how far the *others* must have gone. And what about the other war that was raging as James wrote his epistle—the one in Britain? Could it be that some of the apostles made it as far as the British Isles?

# One True Religion— One True Church!

#### Religion is relevant to life in the 21st century. BY RON FRASER

ESPITE CENTURIES OF SECUlarist efforts to tear religion down, it has returned with a vengeance to become the most divisive force in society today. Whether it be marriage, family, human relations, or discourses on morals and ethics in a confused and confusing society, religion is woven through the entire debate on the future of civilization.

Religions of all forms have created a foundation whole societies for generations.

But it is the two great evangelizing religions—Christianity and Islam—that have wrought so much destruction over the centuries in their clashes against each other, and in recent times caused so much suffering for the Jew in particular. These three religions—Judaism, Islam and Christianity—have had the most powerful influence on society over the past 2,000 years.

Sooner or later, any thinking person who believes in what Sir Winston Churchill termed "divine Providence"

has to ask and seek to answer the question, "What is the true religion?"

So let's consider that question. A good place to start would be to define the term *religion*.

The *Britannica Dictionary* defines it, "Any system of faith and worship." Though such a definition includes all three religions that accept one or both testaments of the book known as the Holy Bible, it also includes those that don't. It is thus too broad for our purpose. We shall

narrow that definition to embrace "A system of faith and worship that claims to believe in the one true Creator and Sustainer of the universe."

As our audience is formed primarily of those who do believe in one omnipotent God, it is to these three predominant religions that we look to prove the answer to our question, "What is true religion?"

#### The Truth About God

Judaism, Islam and Christianity in its three major forms—Roman Catholicism, Orthodox and Protestant—all purport to believe in one true God. To the Jew, that is YHVH, as revealed in the Torah. To the Islamic believer, it is Allah, as revealed in the Koran and the writings of Mohammed. To the Roman Catholic, the Godhead is triune—consisting of the God of the Old Testament, Jesus Christ of the New Testament, and a personified Holy Spirit—plus Mary, queen of heaven. To the Protestant, the Godhead is the trinity, without the attachment to Mary.

Why is it that these three religions, all claiming to believe in the God of the Abraham of the Torah (the Old Testament), two of them claiming Abraham as their ancestor, so thoroughly disagree on a singular definition of the God that Abraham worshiped?

The Old Testament definitions of God are clear, precise and impossible for the open mind to misunderstand. He is the beginning of all things (Genesis 1:1). There are no other gods apart from the one true God (Deuteronomy 4:35, 39; 1 Kings 8:60; Isaiah 45:5; Joel 2:27). He is the first and the last (Isaiah 44:7-8). He prophesies the end from the beginning (Isaiah 46:9-10; 48:3-5). He never changes (Malachi 3:6). He prophesied the coming of the Messiah, the city of His birth, the exact duration of His earthly ministry and His return to set up God's government over all (Daniel 9:25-27; Micah 5:2; Isaiah 9:6-7).

Concerning the true historical figure of the Messiah, Jesus Christ, those familiar at the time with the prophecies of His coming to the Earth to fulfill His short 3½-year ministry would have known the prophesied timing and location of His birth in Bethlehem. That is clearly why scholars of those ancient prophecies came to Bethlehem to search Him out in the early autumn of 4 B.C. They had computed the time of the event from the prophetic accounts in the Old Testament (Matthew 2:1-6).

The only provable historic accounts of the Messiah's prophesied birth are

recorded in the New Testament of the Bible. The subsequent eyewitness accounts of His ministry, the history of the early Church, plus that of the first apostles ordained by Jesus Christ, are recorded there.

#### The True Church Must Exist!

Thus to the mind opened to the revelation of truth, there can only be one true religion. "White Cliffs of Dover to be sold to the French to help reduce government's debt" (February 8). Shame on the *Daily Mail*, it was also misleading.

Turns out the famous cliffs aren't for sale. But the *Port* of Dover is under discussion.

After a public outcry, however, Prime Minister Gordon Brown swiftly distanced himself from the idea. "There will be no forced privatization of Dover under [the] Labor [Party]," he said publicly two days after the *Mail's* report.

But is that the end of the story? Not even close.

#### The Gateway to England

The moat separating fortress England from the European continent has always been its most crucial natural defense. The English Channel has been the site of several spectacular victories for Britain—battles in which different outcomes would have radically altered history.

Dover, "the gateway of England," is the island nation's closest point to Europe. It is separated from Calais, France, by a mere 21 miles of churning seawater only 150 feet deep. It has thus been the first point of attack for—and first line of defense against—repeated invasions. Julius Caesar tried to land at Dover in Rome's assault in 55 B.C. Several French forces targeted the port city in the 13th century, as did Napoleon and Hitler.

The town proudly bears the scars of its warring past, relics that silently testify of its indomitability through ages and epochs. The imposing millennium-old Dover Castle is aptly called "the lock and key to the kingdom." Fortifications remain from Roman times, from the Normans, from King Henry VIII, from Queen Elizabeth I, from the Napoleonic wars, from two world wars—constructed by giants of history who recognized Dover's uncommon value over the centuries. Its cliffs hide a massive maze of underground tunnels and soldiers' barracks.

In the 18th and 19th centuries, the town was an enormous garrison bristling with armaments to thwart French attacks. During the Great War, it became "Fortress Dover," one of Britain's most crucial military centers, withstanding several enemy aerial assaults; it hosted warships that protected the channel and welcomed soldiers coming home from battle on the Continent. In World War II it received over 200,000 of the evacuees from Dunkirk, a miraculous operation directed from one





of its underground tunnels. Time after time, Dover has earned its reputation as a symbol of British wartime bravery.

But Britain has changed. To more and more of its people, the nation's remarkable history is not a source of pride, but of shame. They couldn't care less about symbolic value. And the idea that Britain might one day need to defend itself again seems alarmist, even preposterous.

How committed is Britain's government to holding on to Dover, really?

#### Who Owns Britain's Ports?

Prime Minister Brown promised "no forced privatization under Labor."

The catch is, Dover port officials aren't being *forced* to privatize—they are requesting it. The Dover Harbor Board wants a \$645 million expansion of the facility to maintain its status as the biggest freight and passenger ferry port in all of Eu-

rope. Because of public borrowing constraints, the only way it can get the money is from private investors. On January 27, the board officially asked the British government for *permission* to privatize.

Is it far-fetched to think the government will end up approving the request? If it does, this would merely be the latest in a series of British ports being sold to overseas ownership. The United Kingdom has privatized most of its ports industry since 1991, particularly in more recent years. And nearly all the buyers have been foreigners.

This is the result of Britain's desperate need for cash, its undying belief in the virtues of open markets, and its naive faith in the goodwill of the foreigners gaining control over the gates in and out of the country.

Immediately after the Ports Act of 1991, the UK's largest container port, Felixstowe, was gobbled up by Hong Kong corporation Hutchison Whampoa, the company that



now owns the Panama Canal. Hutchison bought 75 percent of the port immediately and completed the process, to 100 percent ownership, in 1994. This marked the beginning of a significant sell-off of Britain's major ports, a dramatic change for what was once the world's dominant trade power.

PD Ports, which operates several UK ports and logistics centers, was sold to an Australian investment fund in 2005. Associated British Ports, which operates 21 UK ports and manages a quarter of the UK's sea-borne trade, was snatched by a foreign consortium led by Goldman Sachs in 2006. The same year, one of the world's largest shipping companies, P&O—the giant Peninsular and Oriental Steam Navigation Company, which was founded in the early 19th century—became a subsidiary of Dubai Ports World, owned by the Dubai government in the United Arab Emirates. The Humber Sea Terminal was also taken over by a Belgian company that year. The UK's third-largest port, Teesport, became owned by a Canadian firm last November.

Ninety-five percent of the UK's international trade flows through its commercial seaports. The bulk of this traffic now passes through ports privately owned by foreigners.

Dover is one of the few British ports—and is the largest—still owned by the

government. In other words, it's something of an anomaly. The trend suggests it is bound to end up the same way all these other major ports have: in foreign hands. For Prime Minister Brown to act as though such a move would be unthinkable is posturing.

#### **Hocking Britain's Assets**

The truth is, Brown says he wants to cut Britain's budget deficit in half within four years. One step toward that goal is a privatization plan he unveiled last autumn—amounting to the sale of \$25 billion in



government assets and property over the next two years. Among the potential prizes exciting interest among investors are the Channel Tunnel Rail Link, the Dartford River Crossing toll bridge, the Royal Mint, air-traffic services operator NATS, the government's oil pipeline system, and the government's 33 percent stake in uranium processor Urenco. Quite a list.

Oh yes—and the Port of Dover. This may not be "forced privatization," but Reuters reported that the government did ask Dover and its other 50 non-profit "trust ports" to submit privatization plans by April. So, clearly, the interests of London and the Dover Harbor Board are aligning. The port is certain to leave government hands at some point, after which feasibly any offshore firm—even a French one—could buy it.

Such a vast sell-off of valuables is quite unprecedented for a government. But the UK has made itself uniquely vulnerable to it. Yes, its nasty economic woes have placed it in deep need of overseas cash, which it has used to finance its record trade deficits. But even more disturbing is the complete lack of concern over protecting the integrity of Britain's strategic national interests—let alone preserving Britain's cultural identity.

In strategically important industry after

industry, Britain has been selling its corporate crown jewels to the highest bidder. As a result, its airports, like its seaports, have gone to offshore ownership. Many of its power utility companies, and its largest water utility, are foreign-owned. The power station construction arm of the government-owned nuclear power manufacturer is now held by a Japanese corporation. The nation's automotive sector has been taken over—as have many of its industrial manufacturers, telecommunications companies and banks—by foreign interests. "It is easier to take over a company here than

anywhere else in the world," Financial Services Secretary Paul Myners told the *Guardian* last September.

Whereas European governments take pride in domestic ownership of certain sectors and routinely block foreign takeovers, the British government patently celebrates the openness of even its most crucial industries to foreign conquest. This impulse is another ugly manifestation of the cultural shame and historical self-loathing that makes

modern Britain so dangerously susceptible to conquest by aggressive foreign cultures and religions.

#### Danger in Foreign Ownership—Prophesied!

Many Brits say the foreign investment only makes Britain stronger. Such thinking fails to imagine the prospect of enemy cunning or ruthlessness; in fact it fails to acknowledge even the possibility of an enemy existing.

Of course foreign ownership brings simple realities, such as owners likely having less compunction about shedding jobs during economic difficulty. But there are also grave potentialities in having British ports, communications and energy firms run by overseas directors and shareholders, whose loyalties lie outside the UK.

The words of Hosea belie the trust Britain has placed in offshore ownership. Speaking of Ephraim, whose end-time descendants are situated in the British Isles (a truth proven in our free book *The United States and Britain in Prophecy*), the prophet wrote, "Ephraim, he hat mixed himself among the people .... *Strangers* [or foreigners] have devoured his strength, and he knoweth it not ..." (Hosea 7:8-9). Time will show that the UK's faith is misplaced. Britain has yet to realize it, but by auctioning off its strategic assets it has rendered

itself peculiarly defenseless and susceptible to foreign aggression.

Another, even earlier prophecy spells out how it will happen. For disobedience to His ways, God warned the ancient nation of Israel—and its modern-day national descendants, of which Britain is one—of oppression by aliens. "The stranger that is within thee shall get up above thee very high; and thou shalt come down very low," He said, "and he shall besiege thee in ALL THY GATES THROUGHOUT ALL THY LAND, which the Lord thy God hath given thee" (Deuteronomy 28:43, 52).

In *The United States and Britain in Prophecy*, Herbert W. Armstrong wrote of how these "gates" included the various sea gates controlled by Britain (and America) at the height of its power—gates that would be subsequently lost and used as weapons to choke off trade routes. Another probable realization of this curse has become vividly clear. Notice: This Israelitish people is prophesied to be *besieged in all its gates* THROUGHOUT ALL ITS LAND. Even now, "strangers" control virtually all the gates in and out of the island nation of Britain!

For now, Dover—"the gateway of

England," "the lock and key of the kingdom," the enduring symbol of Britain's independence and strength—remains in government hands.

Don't expect it to stay so for long. It, like all the other gates the British have so casually surrendered, is bound to feature in a crushing lockdown—a foreign besiegement—that will drive Britain to its knees.

# Will Crisis Oust Britain From the EU?

ORTY years ago, amid great industrial upheaval and economic stagnation, Britain was branded as "the sick man of Europe." Margaret Thatcher rose to the occasion, stared down Britain's militant labor unions, privatized languishing state-run services and rescued the nation from crisis.

There simply is no 21st-century Thatcher to come to Britain's aid amid a far greater crisis facing the nation today.

Britain risks overtaking Greece as the sickest economy in the EU. Yet it is faced with a greater problem than Greece. Greece, as a member of the eurozone, does have a lender of last resort with which to plead its case for a bailout: the European Central Bank. Britain, which refused membership of the euroclub in order to maintain its own pound sterling currency, can hardly seek favor with the Eurobank in times of crisis. It would probably have to turn to the International Monetary Fund, like the Third World nations that usually receive IMF largesse. This would result in a tremendous loss of national prestige—that is, assuming embattled Britain has any remaining prestige to lose.

Writing for the *Telegraph*, Ambrose-Evans Pritchard mused, "The Greek crisis is a dress rehearsal for attacks on any sovereign state with public accounts in disarray. While Britain went in to this crisis with a much lower public debt than Greece or Italy (though higher total debt than either), it now has the highest budget deficit in the OECD [Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development] rich club—and perhaps the world—at 13 percent of GDP.

"I have a very nasty feeling that markets are about to pounce on Britain. . . . A disorderly fall in sterling at this stage (i.e. collapse) could prove as traumatic as default" (February 15).

A few days later, the *Telegraph* reported, "Britain's public finances may end this year in a worse state than those of Greece, economists warned yesterday, raising serious fears over the economic stability of the country" (February 19).

Emphasizing the problem, the annual January surge in tax receipts that normally boost the British Treasury did not occur. Instead, for the first time in 17 years, public finances plunged into the red in the first month of the year. Official figures showed that the government actually borrowed £4.3 billion in January to keep the nation afloat. "The Office for National Statistics said the government had never before had to borrow cash in January, adding that the shortfall meant it had now borrowed £122 billion so far this financial year, equivalent to around £2,000 for every man, woman and child in the country" (ibid.).



The cost of such borrowing is proving more expensive to Britain than the cost of loans to the ailing Spanish and Italians. Added to this is the huge exposure of British banks to those EU nations presently in the greatest economic difficulty, the so-called Club Med, or PIGS nations—Portugal, Italy, Greece and Spain. A consequence of all this, which just adds to Britain's financial and economic woes, is that the market is not buying British bonds. Then there's the bad news from the real-estate market, indicating that mortgage lending fell by 32 percent in January.

This all adds up to one sorry mess for Britain. It is not only that Britain risks the loss of its triple-A credit rating. Leading academics, economists and businessmen have warned that "without action on the public finances, Britain could face a crippling fiscal crisis" (ibid.).

Over the past 20 years, Britain has increasingly sold off not only crucial businesses but also numerous strategic assets. It has even yielded up the administration of some of its counties to foreign entities. Yet, despite retaining its beloved but battered pound sterling, Britain long ago began signing over its national sovereignty to the European Union. That action was consummated with the government signing the European constitution, thus virtually making Britain an EU vassal state subject to the whim of Brussels/Berlin.

Herbert Armstrong prophesied long ago that Britain would either opt out or be kicked out of the European Union. The day of that occurring may be closer than we think. If Berlin is prepared to play hardball with a fellow European nation like Greece when it is in a tough spot, what do you really think, based on the lessons of history alone, it might do to the offshore islands of Britain if faced with a similar situation there? Britain has placed its economy in a tenuous situation by allowing not only many of its top brand names to be taken over by EU member nations, in particular Germany, but too many of its strategic assets—and too much of its national debt, also.

rope's Central Bank was asked in January whether Greece posed a threat to the monetary union. He replied that the crisis in Greece was greatly overstated and told reporters that if they wanted to worry about something, they should worry about California.

Right now, Greece is synonymous with an economic red alert. Without a bailout, the entire country could face debt default. Standards of living are plummeting; unions are already staging mass strikes, and money is fleeing the country.

Is it possible California the seventh-largest economy in the world—could actually be in a more dangerous situation? Could California set off a Greek-style economic crisis in America? Some say yes.

#### **Too Much in Common**

In some ways, Greece and California are very similar. Both have high unemployment and falling tax receipts. Both also have bloated public sectors with lavish retirement and pension plans that are underfunded and unsustainable. Both have gridlocked governments comprised of

politicians incapable of working together to make hard choices.

Greece and California are also members of a larger union that shares a common currency. Each state also has specific trade relationships as well as financial interrelations with others inside the union. And both states have the worst credit ratings within their unions. As with Greece, it costs more to insure California debt against default than it does to insure Kazakhstan.

Both Greece and California are dominated by special interest groups and handicapped by unions. Chronic overspending has become endemic and uncontrollable in both locales. And both states are bankrupt.

Critics of the economic doomsaying point out that there are big differences between Greece and California. There *are* differences, but not all of them are good. In some ways, *California could actually be a greater threat to its union*.

California's debt is supposedly far less

than that of Greece. California's debt reportedly equals about 7 percent of its economy. In Greece, the ratio is around 100 percent. On the surface, Greece looks much worse off.

In reality, comparing total California debt to total Greece debt is like comparing rotten apples to rotten oranges. To make it a fair comparison, you also need to factor in California's share of the national debt (which is projected to be \$14 trillion by year end). When this amount is factored in, the \$68 billion that the state owes (as of the end of 2009) balloons to \$1.65 trillion—which means that California's actual debt-to-GDP ratio is almost 90 percent.

Yet, as horrendous as a debt-to-economy ratio of 90 percent is, California's ratio is even greater. When including unfunded Social Security, Medicare and Medicaid liabilities into the equation, California's state debt-to-GDP ratio soars to a stratospheric 400 percent.

That means California debt equals more than \$200,000 per man, woman and child. Where will the money come from?

A California debt default would be far more damaging to the U.S. than anything a Greek failure could produce. Besides being far smaller, Greece's economy makes up only 3 percent of the total eurozone. California, however, composes about 12 percent of the U.S. economy.

Plus, a California default could disproportionately hurt many U.S. states. According to the ECB president, Jean Claude Trichet, cumulative U.S. state budget deficits amount to 12 percent of America's gross domestic product. In Europe, the figure is only 7 percent.

#### Looking in the Mirror

Portugal may be a problem. But so is Ohio. Think things are tough in Ireland? Look at Kentucky. Is Spain having unemployment issues? So are Florida, Illinois and Michigan. While analysts focus on Greece, they are missing the rhinoceros in the flower garden.

David Walker is the former U.S. comptroller general,

which means he was America's top auditor. He says America only has a couple of years to deal with its deficit problems before it ends up like Greece. America could face a "crisis of confidence with regard to our own finances" if we don't start being honest with our budgets, he says. Walker, who is now working to bring attention to America's financial irresponsibility, warns that a big part of America's problem is its use of "creative accounting practices"—the same ones that burned Greece.

Events in Europe surrounding Greece are pivotal, and could have dramatic economic and geopolitical ramifications (article, page 2). But when comparing Greece and California, don't forget that California's economy is five times larger. The EU could survive without Greece, but America will not survive without California.

Unfortunately for California and the rest of America, watching the Greece crisis is rather like looking in a mirror.



# Why China Is Fleeing the Dollar

ost Americans have little idea what is happening to the economy. Many people think America is emerging from a vicious little recession and will soon be back on the road to prosperity. America always has, so it always will, is the common reasoning.

Yet this time, things may turn out very different. On January 8, CNBC reported that the U.S. Federal Reserve purchased an unprecedented 80 percent of all U.S. treasury securities issued in 2009.

This is earthshaking, game-changing news with possibly lethal repercussions. Here is why.

#### **How America Went Into Debt**

During 2009, the federal government ran a \$1.4 trillion deficit—the largest in world history, *more than triple* the size of the previous year's record-breaking deficit.

Since Americans save so little money, foreigners have come to provide almost all the federal government's borrowing needs in recent years. They do this by purchasing U.S. treasury bonds. This was a win-win for them: Not only would they earn interest on their money, but also, since American consumers tend to spend the borrowed money purchasing foreignmade goods, a good proportion of the money cycled right back to them.

From 2006 through November 2009, Beijing lent \$527 billion to America through treasury purchases alone. Hong Kong lent an additional \$100 billion. Other countries like Japan lent hundreds

of billions more. Then there were the hundreds of billions of dollars they lent to government-sponsored entities like mortgage giants Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac.

But now it is as if the foreign nations see the writing on the wall. They realize that America is addicted to debt and that their loans might never get repaid. As a result, America's most important source of lending is drying up.

#### Want to Buy Some Treasuries?

On February 17, the Department of the Treasury reported that last December, foreign demand for U.S. treasury securities fell by more than in any month ever recorded.

China led the pack. It reduced its dollar holdings by over \$34 billion—about 4 percent of its holdings. For six months in a row, China not only stopped lending money to the federal government, it actu-

ally sold treasuries.

China has been America's most important creditor. Is China just rebalancing its portfolio for the short term, or is this the beginning of a structural move away from the dollar? If China is trying to quietly get out as much of its money as possible while it can, the greenback could be in a lot of trouble. At the very least, it could mean higher interest rates for America—which would really hurt consumers, who are loaded with debt. Not only that, but it would set a dangerous precedent. China holds most of the world's supply of investable funds. That means that where China invests, and how long it supports the dollar, and what it does with its own internal credit policies, sets the tone for investors all over the world.

Perhaps that is why oil-exporting nations like Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Iraq and Venezuela have been net sellers of treasuries since June too. Thus, two of America's four most important foreign creditors are AWOL.

All things being equal, this exodus of foreign money would have caused massive credit contraction capable of smothering America: interest rates skyrocketing into the double digits, zombified Wall Street banks with broken business models, small businesses unable to roll over their debts, a housing market in a renewed free fall, soaring consumer bankruptcies, and unemployment worse than the Great Depression.

So far, this has not happened. Why? Faced with the above list of catastrophes, the Federal Reserve decided to risk the biggest catastrophe of all in a forlorn attempt to avoid the inevitable financial reckoning.

To prop up the economy, the Federal Reserve began doing the one practice anathema to all fiat-currency-based economic systems: creating money out of thin air.

# **Another Anti-U.S. Alliance Is Born**

Latin American and Caribbean nations vote to keep the U.S. out of their affairs. BY RON FRASER

HE WRITING HAS BEEN ON THE wall ever since certain populist leaders gained the upper hand in Latino politics.

Long distracted by events in Europe, the Middle East and the Far East, America has ignored the nations that press against its own back door. Now they are clubbing together to form their own regional alliance to replace the Organization of American States (OAS). The OAS has, to this point, operated as the principle alliance of the Americas, incorporating Canada and the United States. The new alliance is slated to deny Canada and the U.S. a forum at regional summits south of the border.

Washington's reacted to the news with a ho-hum attitude of seeming disinterest. Such a response to current developments in this strategic southern Atlantic/Pacific region will prove disastrous.

#### Integrating

As if to carry more force behind this Latin slap across America's face, it was the leader of America's closest neighbor, Mexico—source of its largest intake of migrant labor and thus of the flight of billions of dollars to destinations south of the border—to deliver the blow.

On February 23, at the conclusion of a two-day summit in Cancun, Mexican President Felipe Calderon announced to participants from 32 Latin American and the Caribbean nations that this new bloc "must as a priority push for regional integration ... and promote the regional agenda in global meetings." Mexico and Brazil are the driving forces behind the new bloc. The name and structure of the new organization will be determined at a summit in Caracas, Venezuela, next year.

In an early sign of strengthening anti-Anglo-Saxon orientation in the region, this Latin bloc threw its weight behind Argentina's renewed calls for Britain to hand over the Falkland Islands to that southern Latino nation.

In an early opinion on the new organization, China, already entrenched in the region, said the development could help Beijing increase its coopera-

tion with Caribbean and Latin American countries. *China Daily* reported that "Trade between China and Latin America reached \$111.461 billion in the first three quarters of 2008, with China's direct nonfinancial investment in the region involving trade, manufacturing, gas and oil exploration amounting to \$960 million at the end of June in 2008" (February 22).

Yet observers are cautious as to the new bloc's prospects for success given the disunity that presently divides more conservative leaders in countries such as Colombia, Chile and Peru from the leftists leading Bolivia, Venezuela, Nicaragua and Cuba. Brazil's President Lula da Silva is quite often the balancing factor in any political feuds between these factions.

Despite the show of bravado in seeking to distance the region from Anglo-Saxon influence, Latin America has no real history of intra-regional cohesion. It is not unlike the unwieldy and fractious European Union in this respect. Yet both these regions have one overarching potentially binding force in common that could, amid crisis, rapidly unify their respective masses: Roman Catholicism.

#### What Will Bind Latin America Together?

International relations guru Hans J. Morgenthau famously declared that true power is the control over the mind.

Few pundits in these post-Cold War days appreciate the power of ideology, once unleashed, to control the masses. Too many commentators raised in post-Cold War secularism consider ideology in international relations as passé.

Nothing could be further from the truth. It is ideological extremism that drives hatred of the Jew and Anglo-Saxon



HERE ARE NIGHTMARES OF THE FUTURE FROM which a fortunate collision with some wandering star, reducing the Earth to incandescent gas, might be a merciful deliverance."

Ours is an age of computer chips and automated systems, of GPS's, Blackberrys, laptops and iPods. We live in the space age, an age of satellite-guided, unmanned aircraft and wireless communication.

In 1931, Churchill forecast a time when "explosive forces, energy, materials, machinery, will be available upon a scale which can annihilate whole nations. Despotism and tyrannies will be able to prescribe the lives and even the wishes of their subjects in a manner never known since time began." Take an honest survey of this planet: We are living Churchill's nightmares!

But the Fed didn't just print money to give to the government to spend. It also created close to \$1 trillion to prop up asset prices in America. It printed money to give to the big banks and to purchase toxic mortgages from Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac.

It was theft and highway robbery on a grand scale because the Fed did nothing to earn this money: It simply said it had the money, and it was so. Consequently, all other money in circulation—yours, your grandma's and Uncle Fred's money—became worth less. The Fed now has over \$2 trillion worth of assets on its balance sheet—mostly money it willed into existence over the past year.

No wonder foreigners are beginning to flee the dollar. The Fed is doing what every failed fiat currency system in the history of paper money has done. To governing officials under financial pressure, the temptations of the printing press are too great.

The results are always disastrous. Once you start down the money-printing road, it is almost impossible to turn back.


The history of money printing says the dollar is doomed. Maybe that is why the Chinese have dumped their Fannie and Freddie investments. During 2009, they took the Fed's newly created money and ran while the dollars still had some value remaining. After all, the *dollar has lost almost a third of its value* over the past decade.

#### **Prettying Ourselves Up**

Did you know that this exact scenario in which America finds itself was prophesied thousands of years ago?

Speaking of the modern nations descended from ancient Israel, of which America is currently the most geopolitically prominent, the Prophet Jeremiah warned that a time would come when America's trade partners would abandon it despite America's best attempts to pretty itself up. "And when you are plundered, what will you do?
